Latter part moderate Breeze at South. & foggy cloudy weather, steering sharp By EPE. the crew variously employed darning ships

Tuesday
May 25th

Commences with a strong Breeze at South & hazy weather with a rough sea running. steering By the Wind EPE under single reef topsails.
Middle & Latter part moderate Breezes at SW & large weather steering By the Wind PE. employed repairing the fore hold &c &c

Wednesday
May 26th

Commences with a moderate Breeze & cloudy weather steering By the Wind PE. at 4 PM tacked to the Westward. Middle Do. at 6 AM the Wind shifted to the Northward in a squall. Latter part moderate Breezes from the Northward & thick hazy weather steering WNW.

Thursday
May 27th

Commences with a moderate Breeze at NE & hazy weather steering WNW. Middle Do. Latter part moderate Breezes at NE & large weather steering West saw a number of Birds & Seals & porpoises

Friday
May 28th

Commences with a fine Breeze at NE & cloudy hazy weather. steering WNW. at 1 PM saw a Large Whale. Landed our Boat in pursuit of the Whale struck & killed him at 6 PM. took him along side & cabled him there.
Middle part lying By at 5 AM began cutting at noon finished cutting the Body

Saturday
May 29th

During these 24 hours light Wind & variable from EPE to SW & pleasant weather at 3 PM hauled out the Trawl.
Latter part saw a sail to the Westward cutting in. Whale it proved to be an English Blague

Sunday
May 30th

Commences with a light Breeze from NW & fine pleasant weather. steering By the Wind PE. employed Boiling & skimming down oil.
Middle Do. Latter part strong Wind as above & squally rainy weather. employed skimming down oil in the fore hold. at noon finished Boiling.
Date By C.B.P. 30° 24' N
Long By Chron 162° 08' E

Monday
May 31st

Commences with a strong Breeze at NW & fine weather steering By the Wind WNW employed washing off the ship &c.
Middle Do. Latter part strong Wind attended with squalls of rain. employed breaking out the after hold to get out provisions &c.
