Latter part Light air at North & cloudy steering  
PW employed repairing the try Cambruse &c  
Latitude By CBP 30° 29' N  
Long By AC 162° 00' E

Wednesday  
June 2<sup>nd</sup>

Commenced with a Light air of Wind at NE & thick cloudy weather steering PW employed stowing down oil in the forehold at night shotred sail  
Middle part wind variable from PE to WNW  
Latter part strong Wind at PPW & hard showers of rain  
Latitude By CBP 30° 40' N  
Long By Chr 161° 50' E

Thursday  
June 3<sup>rd</sup>

Commenced with a moderate Breeze from the Westward & thick cloudy squally weather with a rough sea on. Middle Do  
Latter part a fine Breeze at PW & hazy weather steering NW By N a sail in sight to seaward saw great numbers of small Birds  
Latitude By CBP 30° 42' N  
Long By Chr 162° 30'

Friday  
June 4<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with a fine Breeze at PW & hazy weather at 1 PM spoke the slave mentioned ship the Ganges of Bristol R.I. Gardner 20 months out with 100 Bbls of Oil  
Middle & Latter part a fine Breeze at PPW steering By the Wind to the Westward the Ganges in sight  
Latitude By CBP 31° 14'  
Long By Chr 160° 30' E

Saturday  
June 5<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with a fine Breeze at PPW & fine weather steering By the Wind to the Westward with all sail set at employed stowing down oil in the forehold at night finished at 5 PM saw a sail to the Southward - Middle part Lying By -  
Latter part strong Wind & variable from NW to NE & thick squally rainy weather steering WNW the Ganges in sight -  
Latitude By AC 30° 20' N  
Long By AC 159° 30' E

Sunday  
June 6<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with a strong Breeze at NE & thick squally weather steering PW under short sail  
Middle & Latter part much the same steering PW saw nothing that looks like a Whale -  
Latitude By CBP 30° 11' N  
Longitude By Chr 158° 24' E

Monday  
June 7<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with a fine Breeze at NE BE & dark cloudy weather steering PW at night shotred sail at daylight tackd to the Northward -  
Latter part Light air from the Southward steering to the NE at 10 AM spoke the Ship Elizabeth of London Coast (Late Stewart) 18 months out with 450 Bbls of Oil -  
Latitude By CBP 29° 54' N  
Long By Chr 159° 00' E

Tuesday  
June 8<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with Light Wind from PW & fine pleasant weather steering ENE in company with the Elizabeth at 6 PM spoke the Ship Golconda, Pamprun 8 months out with 200 Bbls of Oil - Middle & Latter Do steering as above the Elizabeth in sight -  
Latitude By CBP 30° 15' N  
Long By Chr 159° 25'
