Thursday July 15th Commences with a Light Breeze & fine pleasant weather steering NNE - saw two Ships to Windward Middle Do. at 7 AM spoke Ship R Mitchell Baker with 1300 Bbls of Oil - Lat part squally with light rain - Lat By 6 BP 30-52 N Long By 60 165-50

Friday July 16th Commences with moderate Wind at East & fine weather steering By the Wind NNE - employed repairing a stove Boat Middle Do. Lat part a fine Breeze at NE & pleasant weather steering to the SW - saw a Ship Lat By 6 BP 31-32 N Long By 60 166-00 E

Saturday July 17th Commences with a fine Breeze at NE & fine weather steering WNW at 9 AM spoke Ship Russell North - Middle & Lat Do employed mending a Boat &c &c - Lat By 6 BP 31-52 N Long By 60 164-50 E

Sunday July 18th Commences with a fine Breeze from the NE & fine pleasant weather steering to the WNW - at night tacked to the Eastward - Middle & Lat Do steering to the Eastward Lat By 6 BP 31-30 Long By 60 164-40

Monday July 19th During these 24 hours Light Wind from the NE & fine pleasant weather steering to the NE nothing in sight but a few Porpoises Lat By 6 BP 31-47 N Long By 60 165-30 E

Tuesday July 20th During these 24 hours Light Wind as above & fine pleasant weather steering to the SW - saw a Ship to the Westward - ends Two Day Lat By 6 BP 31-08 Long By 60 166-35

Wednesday July 21st Commences with a Light Breeze & pleasant weather - saw Porpoises - Middle Do - Lat part thick rainy weather Lying By - Lat By 6 BP 31-20 Long By 60 164-00 E

Thursday July 22nd Commences with a Light Breeze from the Southward & thick rainy weather - Middle Do Lat part a Light Breeze at SW & calm steering By the Wind to the Southward a sail in sight to leeward - Lat By 6 BP 31-07 Long By 60 163-36
