Aug 10th Commences with Light airs of Wind at South & cloudy - steering By the Wind WSW the Entrances in sight - Middle & Little Is.

Aug 13th Commences with a moderate Breeze at 1900 & fine pleasant weather steering By the Wind to the Westward - saw a Ship to Leeward - the Watch employed drawing & hoisting yards - &c

Saturday
Aug 14th Commences with a Light Breeze at 1900 & fine pleasant weather steering sharp By ENE the great passage employed at 6 PM tacked to the Southward - at 7 AM saw two Large Whales - at 9 AM Landed our Boats - struck & killed a Large Whale sound

Sunday
Aug 15th Commences with a Light Breeze at 1900 & fine pleasant weather - at 1 PM got the Whales to the Ship - at 2 PM began cutting - at 3 PM saw Whales - Landed our Boats struck two Large Whales - drewed the craft from one & killed the other - at 6 PM got back to the Ship - Middle So employed Boiling at daylight began cutting & finished cutting the Body of the first Whale - Landed two Boats in pursuit of Whale struck & killed a Large Whale - cut in the second Whale while the Boats was off towing the Whale to the Ship at noon got the Whale along side - employed Boiling Lat in 31° 52'

Monday
Aug 16th Commences with calm pleasant weather employed Boiling & Breaking out cask fuel - Middle & Little Is. employed Boiling at noon finished cutting in the Body of the other Whale. Lat By CBP 31° 49'

Long By Chs 161° 50'

Tuesday
Aug 17th Commences with calm warm weather - employed Boiling & cutting in one of the Heads - Middle & Little Is. part fine pleasant weather cut in another Head - Lat By CBP 31° 39'

Long By Chs 161° 40'

Wednesday
Aug 18th Commences with Light airs inclining to Calm & smooth - cut in the Last Head - Middle So employed Boiling - at Noon finished Boiling - Ship in sight to the Eastward
