

Sunday
Sept 14th Commenced with a light Wind at NNW
& fine pleasant weather chased the Whales
till 4 o'clock & came on Board -
at night got near them again lowered
our Boats but night coming on lost
sight of them Middle Is. Lying By
at 8 AM saw a school of Whales -
Lowered our Boats struck & killed a 30 Blk
Whale. Latter part strong Wind & squally
with rain. The Boats off towing the Whale
Lat By 31° 10' N
Long By 162° 00' E

Monday
Sept 15th Commenced with a strong from the NW &
cloudy squally weather at 9 P.M. got the
Whale to the ship - at 4 P.M. began cutting
at 6 P.M. finished cutting
Middle & Latter Is. employed Boiling -
at 11 AM spoke Ship Richmond of N Bedford
Mass. 24 months out with 2150 Bls of Oil -
Lat By 30° 50' N
Long By Choc 161° 50' E

Tuesday
Sept 16th Commenced with strong Wind at NNW
& cloudy with a rough sea on under double
reef Topsails - at 6 PM finished Boiling
Middle Is. - Latter part more moderate;
Wind at NNW steering By the Wind NE
the Ship Richmond in sight 31° 40'
Long 163° 30'

Wednesday
Sept 15th Commenced with a moderate Breeze at NNW & cloudy
weather at 10 AM spoke Ships Lexington & Richmond
Middle Is. Latter part Light air employed stowing
down oil in the fore hold Lat By 31° 50'
Long By Choc 164° 44'

Thursday
Sept 16th Commenced with Light Wind from the NW & fine
pleasant weather steering to the Eastward
employed stowing down oil in the fore hold
Middle Is. Lying By - at daylight raised sail
& steered to the Westward Lat By 31° 53'
Long By 163° 50'

Friday
Sept 17th During these 24 hours moderate Wind from the
NW & fine pleasant weather the Captains employed
reparing oak & setting up shooks -
nothing in sight Lat By 31° 50'
Long By 163° 30'

Saturday
Sept 18th Commenced with a light Breeze at NNW & fine
pleasant weather steering WNW at 4 PM violent
& bent another M/G sail at night here to -
Latter part moderate Breeze at NE & fine weather
steering NW Lat By 31° 20' N
Long By Choc 163° 10' E

Sunday
Sept 19th Commenced with a Light Breeze at NE & cloudy
steering NE - at 9 PM saw a Carcass
at night shot dead sail -
Latter part a Light Wind at NNW & fine pleasant
weather steering to the Westward with all sail
set Lat By 30° 48' North
Long By Choc 162° 32' E

Monday
Sept 20th Commenced with a Light air at NW & cloudy steering
By the Wind WNW with all sail set - a great swell
heaving from the Westward
Middle & Latter Is. at 1 AM spoke Ship
Canton Gardner of N Bedford with 2000 Bls of Oil
Lat By 31° 34'
Long By 162° 00' E
