Jan 8<sup>th</sup> During these 24 hours moderate trades & fine weather - steering NW. at night shortened sail - in light & bent another foresail.  
Latitude By 6 B.P. 1° 48' South  
Longitude By Chro 155° 40' W

Sunday  
Jan 9<sup>th</sup> During these 24 fine trades & pleasant weather steering NW. at 5 P.M. saw a school of sperm whales - first in pursuit of them chased till they came on board - at night shortened sail  
Latitude By 6 B.P. 1° 11' S  
Longitude By Chro 155° 59' W

Monday  
Jan 10<sup>th</sup> Commences with a fine breeze & pleasant weather steering by the Wind to the Northward, at night shortened sail  
Mistake & latter do steering NW nothing in sight but a few Birds -  
Latitude By 6 B.P. 00° 12' S  
Longitude By C.C. 156° 55' W

Tuesday  
Jan 11<sup>th</sup> During these 24 hours moderate trades & pleasant weather first part steering NW at night wore ship a took in sail - at daylight steered NW by the Wind with all sail set  
Latitude By 6 B.P. 00° 36' S  
Longitude By Chro 157° 40' W

Wednesday  
Jan 12<sup>th</sup> Commences with a moderate trades & pleasant weather steering SW by the Wind with all sail on - nothing in sight at night shortened sail at daylight steered SW -  
Latter part moderate trades & pleasant steering as above -  
Latitude By 6 B.P. 1° 33' S  
Longitude By Chro 158° 45' W

Thursday  
Jan 13<sup>th</sup> Commences with a moderate breeze & fine weather steering SW at 4 P.M. hauled the ship up PE at night shortened sail at daylight wore ship to the Northward - at 8 A.M. saw Breaches to the Northward of us. at 9 A.M. came up with them - they proved to be sperm whales -  
Lowered our Boats struck a small whale drove the Chapt.  
Latter part strong trades the Boats still in pursuit of the Whales -  
Latitude By a.C. 1° 40' S  
Longitude By a.C. 159° 00' W

Friday  
Jan 14<sup>th</sup> During these 24 hours strong trades and hazy weather the Boats chased the Whales till 3 P.M. & came on Board at night shortened sail - Latter part strong trades at East steering by the Wind N.E. at noon tacked to the Northward -  
Latitude By 6 B.P. 2° 22' S  
Longitude By Chro 159° 14' W

Saturday  
Jan 15<sup>th</sup> Commences with a strong trade at East & hazy weather - steering by the Wind N.B.E. employed repairing a jib &c &c &c &c at night took in sail and wore ship to the North - Latter part strong trades at East & hazy steering by the Wind N.N.E. -  
Latitude By 6 B.P. 1° 22' S  
Longitude By Chro 159° 18' W

Sunday  
Jan 16<sup>th</sup> Commences with fresh trades at East & fine weather steering sharp by N.N.E. - at night shortened sail  
Latter part moderate trades & pleasant weather steering North - saw a number of Boobies, Frigate Birds &c  
Latitude By 6 B.P. 00° 39' S  
Longitude By Chro 159° 28' W
