

Sunday
Feb 13th During these 24 hours strong trades & hazy weather - at 6 PM tacked to the Northward & took in sail - saw great numbers of Boobies & Men of War Birds.
Latitude By 6 BP 08° 07' N
Longitude By Chron 176° 17' W

Monday
Feb 14th Commenced with moderate trades at East & fine weather steering By the Wind to the NE at night took in sail.
Middle Do - at 7 AM saw a school of Spinn Whales - Landed our Boats in pursuit of them. But could not strike. Latter part strong Wind attended with squalls of rain - at noon came on Board.

Tuesday
Feb 15th Commenced with strong Wind with squalls of rain - at 2 PM saw a school of Whales put off in pursuit of them struck & killed two school Whales - at 3 PM got them to the ship - at 6 PM finished cutting. Middle part squally with rain - at 7 AM began Baling.
Latter part strong trades employed Baling.
Latitude By 6 BP 08° 25' N
Longitude By AC 176° 58' W

Wednesday
Feb 16th Commenced with a moderate Wind at East & hazy weather employed Baling.
Middle squally with rain - at 3 AM finished Baling.
Latter part strong trades with light rain some.
Latitude By 6 BP 08° 47' N
Longitude By AC 177° 20' W

Thursday
Feb 17th Commenced with a moderate Wind & variable from NE to East - employed mending & stowing Boat & an Old Main & 9 sail - at 5 PM squally with rain - took in sail.
Middle & Latter part thick & squally rainy weather.
Longitude By AC 177° 45' W

Friday
Feb 18th Commenced with Light Wind & thick cloudy weather steering By the Wind NE & employed mending a Main & 9 sail.
Middle & Latter part Light Wind at EN E & fine weather - employed repairing a Main sail.
Latitude By 6 BP 11° 11' South
Longitude By Chron 177° 48' W

Saturday
Feb 19th Commenced with a light Wind at EN E & fine pleasant weather - at 5 PM bent the Main sail - at night took in sail & were Ship to the NE - saw a dead Whale.
Middle & Latter Do employ wetting the Hold & ran over the ship.
Latitude By 6 BP 08° 25' N
Longitude By AC 178° 06' W

Sunday
Feb 20th Commenced with a moderate wind from the Westward & fine weather steering by the Wind to the Northward - at night took in sail - at daylight saw a school of Spinn Whales - put off in pursuit of them struck & killed 5 school Whales - at 10 AM took them to the Ship - Latter part strong Wind at East employed mending.
Latitude By 6 BP 08° 13' N
Longitude By AC 178° 20' W
