March 11th Commences with moderate Wind at NEBN steering NWBN. at 6 PM the North West part of the Isle Bore ENE Dist 3 Leagues Middle to Lying By - Latter part Right air at NEBE & hazy weather steering By the Wind NW saw Papoises employed getting off the middle croft of the fore top & get up a topmast to secure the Head off the foremast it being rotten

March 12th Commences with moderate Breezes at NEBE & hazy weather, steering By the Wind NBN employed getting up a topmast to secure the Head of the foremast - Middle & Latter part steering By the Wind to the Northward

March 13th Commences with light Wind at NE & fine weather steering By the Wind NBN at night took a sail Middle & Latter part Calm with thick rainy weather at 1 PM saw an Island Bearing PPW Dist 10 miles - Lat's By CBP 1830 P

Monday
March 14th Commences with a moderate Wind at NE & cloudy weather steering SW about 10 miles to the Northward of the above Isle - at 6 PM the Isle bore ENE per compass Dist 11 Miles at 6 PM squally with rain Double reef the topsails & headed to the Westward. Middle part calm Latter part a fine Breeze from NBN & fine weather steering SWBN saw Papoises

Tuesday
March 15th Commences with a fine Breeze from the Northward & fine weather steering to the Westward at 1 PM unbent the Foremast staysail to repair it at 2 PM sent down the Mizzen Top 9 Yard to repair the sail at 4 PM bent the staysail again at 5 PM the Wind shifted to the Westward in a squall close reef the topsails & wore ship to the Northward at 6 AM tacked to the Westward at 8 AM saw a small Island Bearing NBE Dist about 6 Leagues Latter part strong Wind & variable with hard squalls of rain double reef the topsails & end.

March 16th Commences with strong Wind at West & squally rainy weather headed to the NNW under short sail at 8 PM wore ship to the NW Middle part light Wind with light rain at 6 AM saw an Island Bearing NNE Dist 12 miles Distance - at 9 AM Wore ship tacked to the Southward
