weigh - at 2 PM The Marquis of Landsdown
of London - Capt Plant anchored there
18 months out with 700 Bbls of Oil
at 9 PM took an anchor and walked
up off the Town - to get off refreshments
at 6 AM the Boat went on shore
Latter part Light trades & fine pleasant
weather - employed getting off Potatoes & Yams
Lying off Guam -

Sunday Commences with light trades & fine weather
May 8th Lying off & on ahead of the Town getting of
vegetables - Middle part Calm
Latter part moderate trades & fine
weather - getting of Potatoes Yams &c &c -

Monday Commences with moderate trades & fine
May 9th weather employed getting of vegetables &c
at 4 PM - got on Board with the Boat
made sail & stood to the Southward.
Middle Do - Latter part a fine Trade as before
& pleasant weather steering to the Northward
employed coopers down the Cables &c &c
the Pilot returned right to
the Eastward Lat 3, 40 14 - 30 N
Lon. 144 10 E
