May 28th

Commences with a moderate Breeze & fine pleasant weather steering to the Eastward the Ship Arabella still in company - Middle part equally running to the Eastward under short sail - at 11 AM spoke the Ship John Palmer of London - Clark 22 months out with 1350 Bbls of Oil - at noon saw a Large Whale put off in company with the John Palmer & Arabella's Boat. Lat By 5B.P. 31-07 N Long By 2C 159-18 E

Sunday

May 29th

Commences with a Light Wind & variable from West to North & hazy weather the Boat off chasing the Whale - at night came on Board. Middle part three sails - at NN E Lying By - Latter part more moderate head sail to the Eastward under short sail the Arabella in sight to leeward Lat By 5B.P. 30-36 N Long By 2C 157-49 E

Monday

May 30th

Commences with a Strong Wind at NNE & clear weather turning By the Wind East under double reef Topsails. Middle Do Latter part - a moderate Breeze from the westward steering ENE - saw a number of Birds Lat By 5B.P. 30-43 N Long By 2C 161-50 E

Tuesday

May 31st

Commences with a moderate Breeze at NNW & fine weather steering ENE - Middle Do at 4 AM equally with rain Latter part fine Wind & variable from PW to W attended with squalls of rain steering ENE Lat By 5B.P. 31-00 N Long By 2C 163-20 E

Wednesday

June 1st

Commences with a strong Wind at West & hazy weather steering EBN under Double reef Topsails - emp Payell repairing an old Topsail & saw no other ships - Middle Do steering East under short sail at daylight saw a Sail standing to the Eastward at 2 PM spoke the above Ship the Pacific of N Bedford Chase 18 months out with 1500 Bbls of Oil - saw two other sail to the Eastward Lat By 5B.P. 31-43 N Long By 2C 165-17 E

Thursday

June 2nd

Commences with a leading Breeze at WNW & cloudy steering East in company with the Ship Pacific saw 4 other Ships Middle Do Lying By - Latter part Light air from the Westward steering to the Eastward the Pacific & 4 sail of Whalers in sight saw Carboises Lat By 5B.P. 30-08 N Long By 2C 166-5 E

Friday

June 3rd

Commences with a moderate Breeze from the Westward & clear pleasant weather steering to the Eastward in company with the Pacific Middle Do Latter Do Lat By 5B.P. 29-50 N Long By 2C 166-45 E

Saturday

June 4th

Commences with a Light Breeze & fine weather steering to the Eastward the Pacific in sight Middle Do Latter part a light Breeze at NNW & pleasant steering to the Eastward saw 3 packets & 1 Grampian Lat By 5B.P. 29-47 N Long By 2C 167-37 E
