Sept 15th Commences with a light Breeze at NE & fine weather. struck & killed a Large Whale took her to our Ship. at 4 PM began cutting Middle Do Lying Bays. at day light began cutting. at 11 PM finished cutting & began Boiling - saw Whales to Leeward the Phoenix & took two 350 lbs Whales & took them a long way

Friday
Sept 16th Commences with a moderate Breeze & fine weather employed Boiling. 4 Ships in sight. Middle & Latta Do employed as above. 3 sail in night two of them Boiling

Saturday
Sept 17th Commences with a strong Wind at NE & cloudy weather. headed to the SE employed Boiling - in company with the Ship Phoenix, at 6 PM squally with rain. at 11 PM finished Boiling. Middle part Calm
Latta part a light Wind at ENE & fine weather. steering to the Northwest in company with the Phoenix. 3 other ships in night.

Sunday
Sept 18th Commences with a light Wind at PE & fine weather steering to the NNE. at 6 PM spoke Ship Superior Fetch of N London Middle & Latta Do steering to the NE
Lat By 60° 30' 19"
Long By Ch. 160 5.5'

Monday
Sept 19th Commences with a light Breeze at SE & some pleasant weather steering to the Eastward in company with Ship Phoenix of New London. Middle & Latta Do employed filling up. Grazing and dividing oil with the Phoenix he took 800 to 112 Galls from our ships.

Long By 162 00 E

Tuesday
Sept 20th Commences with a moderate Wind at SE & steering by the Wind to the NE. at 9 PM parted company with Ship Phoenix. Middle & Latta Do employed stowing down. Oil between decks the Whale weight Latta made 107 Bbls of Oil. Lat By 60° 31' 31" N
Long By Ch. 162 47 E

Wednesday
Sept 21st Commences with a moderate Breeze at SE & fine pleasant weather steering by the Wind E. at 2 PM finished stowing down oil. Middle Do Latta part calm pleasant weather variously employed about the Rigging &c.
Lat By 60° 31' 41" N
Long By Ch. 163 32 E

Thursday
Sept 22nd Commences with calm pleasant weather employed repairing the Larboard Boat & Mizen Top of Sail - saw Blackfish. Middle Do - at 6 AM saw a school of Whales Landed our Boats in Pursuit & then struck & killed 3 small Whales at 7 AM got them to the Ship. at noon finished cutting
