Friday Commences with a fine Breeze at NE & N
Feb 3rd & clear pleasant weather steering NE & N
saw Porpoises Black fish & Finbacks -
at 6 PM shot red seal. Middle part steering
North under that sail. Latter part a fine
trade at E & fine pleasant weather steering
NE By N. with all sail set saw Black fish
& Porpoises employed Painting Spars, tarring Rigging
& various other jobs. Latitude By 63° 00. 25 P
Long - By 113. 00

Saturday Commences with a fine trade at PE &
Feb 4th clear pleasant weather steering NE & N. with
all sail set employed Painting Spars.
Middle & Latter part much the same
steering NE - employed setting the hold
Lat By 63° 00. 18 N
Long By Ch 113. 34

Sunday Commences with light trade at E & fine
Feb 5th pleasant weather steering NW & W with all sail
set. Middle part equally with rain -
Latter part Light Wind at PE & E & fine weather
steering sharp By BM saw Finbacks & Porpoises
Lat By 63° 1-03 P
Long By Ch 114. 30 W

Monday Commences with a Light Wind at EPE &
Feb 6th fine pleasant weather steering By the Wind
to the Southward Middle part equally with
rain. Latter part Light air as above steering
to the Southward saw Finbacks Lat in 2-16 P
Long By Ch 115. 17

Tuesday Commences with a moderate trade & fine weather
Feb 7th steering By the Wind to the Southward. Middle
So Latter part Light equal of Rain saw a Ship
to the NW steering WNW Latitude By 63° 3-37. 0
Long By Ch 115. 18
Long By 63° 115. 00

Wednesday Commences with a Light Wind at EPE &
Feb 8th cloudy steering By the Wind to the Southward
employed repairing an old fore top of Paul
Middle do - at 6 AM saw two sperm Whales
put off in pursuit of them but could not
strike at 10 AM came on Board.

the Whales - struck & killed a 65 Dbl Whale
at 5 PM got him to the ship - and called
