March 30th clear pleasant weather steering NWBW
at 2 PM spoke the Ship. Middle &
Latter Do - the Purft in sight ahead,
Latter Day 60P 11-03 N

Thursday Commences with a fine trade at NEBE
March 31st & fine weather steering NWBW. Middle &
Latter a strong Wind at EBN steering as
above. Latter Day 60P 12-20
Long Day Chw 142-15 W

Friday Commences with a fine trade at East &
March 31st fine pleasant weather steering NWBW
employed repairing the Mizen Top & sail
& Boiling oil. Latter Day 60P 13-35
Middle & Latter Do. Long Day AC 144-00 W

Saturday Commences with Light air & variable
March 31st steering NWBW at 2 PM saw a school
of Hump Whales put off in pursuit of
them struck & killed 15 school whales at
9 PM got them to the Ship
at 6 AM began cutting. at noon finished
cutting - all but two heads - Latter Day 60P 13-40
Long Day AC 144-10

Sunday Commences with calm pleasant weather
April 1st employed cutting in & clearing away
Toads - at 6 PM began Boiling
Middle part thick squally weather with hard
showers of rain.
Latter part thick cloudy weather with light
rain employed setting up shooks & Boiling
Latter Day AC 14-00 W
Long Day AC 144-30 W

Monday Commences with Light air & Wind at ENE
April 2nd with Light rain. employed Boiling steering
NW under short sail.
Middle & Latter much the same -
Latter Day 60P 15-00 N
Long Day AC 145-20 W

Tuesday Commences with a moderate Wind at NE
April 3rd & thick Cloudy weather headed to the NW
under short sail. Middle part Wind at
North with squalls & rain employed Boiling
Latter part calm rainy weather at 6 AM
finished Boiling. Latter Day 60P 15-30 N
Long Day AC 146-30

Wednesday Commences with a Light Wind at NW &
April 4th with Light rain. employed storing
down at iron the main hatchway at 5 PM
a fine Breeze at 12-15 the Ship NWBW
Middle & Latter part a fine Breeze at NWBW
& fine pleasant weather steering NWBW
