

Tuesday Jan 12th

Strong gales from W and
Some Squally but Clear most the time, Heavy
Sea on, First part Carrying Double reefed topsails
and Lark and Courses, Heading S.W. Latter part
Carrying Close reefed topsails and Reefed Courses,
A Whale Ship in Sight by the wind on our weather
in quarter, Saw a Ship past us Steering to the
Eastward, Under all Sail, Saw a gam of Porpoises

Wednesday Jan 13th

Commenced with strong wind
from W.S.W. and Squally weather, Heading S.W.
Carrying Reefed topsails, At 3 P.M. tacked, Heading
S.W. In the morning Set all sail, better weather,
Taped a Ship to the windward of us, At 5 P.M.
tacked Heading S.W. At 12 tacked Heading S.W.
Wind light and Chazy, Saw Porpoises

Thursday Jan 14th

First part light variable wind from
W. Standing upon opposite tack, All Sail Set, Fair
weather, Latter part took a fresh wind from S.W.
Heading W.S.W. to S.W. Carrying Main top gallant
Sail, Heavy Swell from W, At 6 moderate
Set all sail, Blue water, Saw 2 Grampaces
and some Porpoises

Friday Jan 15th

Light variable wind from
the Westward and some Squally, but fair
weather for the most part, Standing upon oppo-
site tack, Heading S.W. and most the time
S.W. All Sail Set, Saw a Finback and some
Porpoises. Lat 54° 05' 02" Long 75° 45'

Saturday Jan 16th

First part light wind from
S.W. Steering W. All Sail Set, At 1 P.M. Calm
At 2 took a breeze from S.W. by W. Heading S.W. by W.
Had very fine weather for Cape Horn, but saw
the Swell begins to roll along from the W and
the Clouds thick heavy in the West, Saw 1
wish to make a northward course, Saw 3 Fin-
backs and a Ship Steering to the S.E. Green water
Blue water

Sunday Jan 17th

First part fresh wind from
S.W. Heading W. in to a head swell, All
Sail Set, At 12 at night wind hauled to S.W.
E and blew on with rain, At 2 A.M. Reaped
the topsails, Clouded strong with a thick rain
storm, Steered W.S.W. At 4 A.M. wind E. Had
the appearance of the wind coming sudden to the
West, but thickened up again and hauled to S.W.
then to S.W. and Clouded a gale, taken fore
and Mizzen topsails, and ran under a Close reefed
Main topsail and reefed foresail, Steering
S.W. by W. At 5 P.M. Cleared off, Wind more moder-
ate from S.W. Set the fore and Mizzen top-sail
Close reefed, Saw a Right Whale and a number
of Porpoises and caught a Right whale porpoise

Lat 54° 05' 53" Long 74° 00'

Monday Jan 18th

Commenced with fresh wind
from W.S.W. and good weather, Steering S.W.
All Sail Set, At 1 P.M. hauled to S. Heading
W by S, had the appearance of rain again
Saw a number Finbacks and a Sail to the South
of us
