

Tuesday Jan 19th

Commences with a fresh breeze from N.E.W. Heading W to N.E.W. Carrying reefed topsails. Latter part strong wind from W to N.E.W. Heading N.E.W. to N. Carrying whole topsails. Two ships passed us steering to the South. Thick fog at times. Saw plenty of porpoises. Blue water.

Lat 34° 49' 40" Long 118° 15'

Wednesday Jan 20th

Fresh breeze from N.E.W. and a thick fog. Heading N.E. All sail set. Saw some porpoises. Dark colored water. Some gulls flying about the ship. Bill is well and on deck. I wish the wind to shift so we can steer W. N.E.W.

Lat 34° 47' 50" Long 118° 00'

Thursday Jan 21st

Fresh breeze from N.E.W. to N.W. standing upon opposite tacks. Heading mostly on the northern tack. At first part of the day in thick green water. Till heading N.W. by W. changed the water to blue. Saw some birds. Hoping for the wind to fall more southerly so as to lay along the coast to the N. Foggy most the time.

Lat 34° 46' 10" Long 117° 47'

Friday Jan 22nd

First part heading N.W. by W. all sail set. Wind from N.W. Latter part heading N. Wind N.E.W. Thick fog most the time. Green blue water. An old Swell coming from W.

Lat 34° 45' 12" Long 117° 45'

Saturday Jan 23rd

Commences with fresh wind from N.W. Heading N.W. by W. Carrying whole topsails. Fair weather. Blue water. A sail in sight a Stern coming up we steered N.E. At 6 P.M. came up squally and blizzardy. Close reefed the topsails and kept the fore sail. Took in the main sail. Wind hauled to N.E.W. Steered N.E.W.

Lat 34° 43' 30" Long 117° 15'

Sunday Jan 24th

First part of the day strong gale from S.W. Steering N.E.W. Carrying close reefed topsails. Latter part fresh breeze from S.W. and fine weather. Steering N.W. All sail set. Blue water. Nothing in sight. Three boat swimmers off. Ducky Dick.

Lat 34° 40' 35" Long 116° 35'

Monday Jan 25th

Light airs from S.W. and pleasant weather. Steering N.E. All sail set. Saw 3 sail steering to the N.W. Saw a gam of black fish going to the N.E. Lowered and chased them without success. Got air spair anchor out and put it on the starboard bow. Island of Mocha 40 mile off. Blue water.

Lat 34° 39' 30" Long 116° 35'

Tuesday Jan 26th

Light breeze from S.W. Calm. Steering N.E. by E till 12 M. then steered N.E. till 1 P.M. (Lat 34° 34' Long 116° 27') then steered E.N.E. Caught a Sunfish. Thick green water. Saw some Mollusks and 2 swordfish. At 3 P.M. saw Mocha Barren N.E. and saw the land to the S.E. of it. Heavy swell heaving in from the S.E.W. stood well over
