Carrying all sail, the same vessel in sight a lead Witches employed on the rigging, Cooper overhauling the old Cask and repairing them on the braker too, Black Smith and Carpenter to work at their trades, There was seen a grate deal of Sperm Oil taken along here the last year, So at 7 P.M. I Cluffed too for the night in hope of seeing Sperm Whale on the morrow

Saturday Feb 13th Lat by Ob 17, 15 Long W by Ch 88, 30

Light Wind from E.S.E. and fair weather, At 4 A.M. Steered off W.S.W. and set all sail, Saw nothing through the Day, Witches employed at Ship's Duty, At 12 M. Cleared up Deck, being Saturday and let the men have the after noon to wash their cloths.

Sunday Feb 14th Lat by Dr 18, 38 Long by Dr 89, 10

Light wind from E and Cloudy and flauy, steering W.S.W. All sail set, Saw nothing through the Day

Monday Feb 15th Lat by Ob 17, 30 Long W by Dr 90, 40

Light Wind from E.S.E. and Cloudy weather, steering W.S.W. Carrying all sail, Saw some Shep Sack by around the Ship, caught 4, Witches employed in Ship's Duty, Broke out a lot of old braker and Cask and Cooper over hauled them

Lat by Ob 16, 35 Long by Dr 92, 00

Tuesday Feb 16th Sperm

Light wind from E.S.E. and fine weather, steering W.S.W. Carrying all sail, Saw nothing, Witches employed in overhauling the masting and taring the bare places on the rigging, No tier slow getting along

Wednesday Feb 17th Lat by Ob 13, 15 Long W by Ch 95, 43

Light wind from E.S.E. and a little Squally, steering W.S.W. Carrying all sail, Saw some Codfish, Set the mizen rigging up, Putting Kicks to some of the Boats

Thursday Feb 18th Lat by Dr 14, 00 Long W by Dr 97, 00

Light wind from E.S.E. and fine weather, first part steering W.S.W., Carrying all sail, At 6 A.M. Will raised a gam of Sperm whale right ahead and going to the Westward slowly, At 7 A.M. went and got a 20 blb whale on tooth him along side, Draped a loose whale at the whaler went to the Windward, then they turned off to the leeward again, Struck another one tooth him along side, fabled the gam off to the leeward and got a Nother and got him along side at 4 P.M. and cut one of the whales in and let the other 2 lay for the night, Cleared away the dead through the night and got being the mucky for starting, The whales last seen were bound off to the S.W. We have got a good log with, Saw black fish around the whaler, In the morning the whales were scattered around and may quite at home, Mr Cuffe lost 2 Shals of line by letting go to the end
