

Sunday May 16th

First part light airs from
S.E. and fine weather. At daylight in the morning
Set all sail and stood to the E.S.E. around the ice
About 20 sail in sight all working to the S. S. S. S.
port of the day. Moderate wind from E. heading
to the East around the ice in company with
Ship. Timor of Sagharbor, Capt White, Chas Phelps
Spoke Ship. Timor Sagharbor, Plenty of birds

Monday May 17th Lat 54° 17' Long 152° 14'

Light wind from E and fine
weather, standing to the S. Under all sail, Jamed
with Ship Chas Phelps, and Ship or a French
Ship, saw a number of sail, standing to the
S. all along to the W of us,

Tuesday May 18th Lat 54° 56' 55" Long 152° 47'

Light wind from W and fine weather
at 6 P.M. then shut in thick foggy ice along
to the W of us, saw plenty of little ducks on the
water, feeding, saw 2 barges steering to the S.
Under all sail, we are heading S.S.W. and S.W.
Jamed with Chas Phelps and French Espedon
Capt Horn,

Wednesday May 19th Lat 54° 36' 30" Long 151° 30'

Light breeze from N.W. to W and foggy
most the day, carrying all sail, heading from S.S.W. to S.W.
The sea very smooth, Chas Phelps and Espedon accom-
panying,

Lat 54° 40' Long 151° 14'

Thursday May 20th

Light variable wind
from W.S.W. to S.W. and thick foggy till 3 P.M.
then cleared up, saw the French stern, Chas
Phelps accompanying, I went on board the Phelps,
and staid all day, carrying all sail, heading
from S. to W.S.W., very smooth sea, wish-
ing for the wind to shift to the Eastward so
we can run to the Westward

Friday May 21st Lat 55° 18' Long 150° 30'

Commenced with light wind from N.W.
and fine weather, heading W.S.W. then hauled to S. S.W.
and around to S. and very light, steered N.W. S. Chas
Phelps and Espedon in sight. Steering to the Westward.
At 3 P.M. thick foggy, first part the day carrying
fore topmast standing sail, watches making oil
lashings, fired the big gun

Saturday May 22nd Lat 55° 00' Long 149° 40'

First part light wind from S.S.
W and clear part the time, steering N.W. carrying
all sail, Jamed with Ship Espedon and Chas
Phelps, very smooth sea, At 6 P.M. steered
N.W. S. Took a breeze from E.S.E.

Sunday May 23rd Lat 55° 10' Long 148° 00'

Strong wind from N.E. and clear
part the time, first part of the day steering
N.W. latter part S.W. W. carrying all sail,
Strong current setting to the S.W., saw ice
in the morning, At 5 P.M. came to the
main back ice, Tacked Ship and worked to the
S.E. around the ice, Spoke B.K. Bobbert Morris
