

Friday July 16th

Light airs and Calm and thick foggy all Day, Boats off whaling, Saw 2 Whale bones up Bay, Heard from up Bay, 2 whales there, got an old anchor from Shore, Finished bailing, Laying off at Washington Head, Mr Benjamin is better and on Deck

Saturday July 17th

Light airs from NNE and foggy part of the Day, At 9 AM took the anchor made sail and stood towards Foster Head along the Ice, Saw 2 Whale going up Bay, At 12 tacked and stood toward Washington Head and Anchored 3 Ships bailing, All hands employed in bailing now, Down 242 bbls oil

Sunday July 18th

Light airs from N.W. and N.E. and thick foggy all Day, At 11 AM took the anchor and worked to the N for Shanter Bay, Came in to Ice, Heard a number of Horns, Heard a whale blow, I think we are half way from Washington Head to Little Shanter, John Russell's boat came along side with a stinker, Saw the Warren off Washington Head about NE

Monday July 19th

Light wind from N.W. and thick foggy all Day, Heard a Ship to the N and one to the N.W. Laying the anchor with small Kedge off Tailors Bay in the Ice, Hope the foggy will clear up soon

Tuesday July 20th

Light airs from N.E. and thick foggy to the N.E. of the Head, At 6 AM took the anchor and worked to the N.W. Sent 2 boats up Tailors Bay, Worked in to the N.W. of Washington Head, Clear up Bay, Saw the B.K. Warren up Bay bailing, The Miller's boat has got a very large Whale, 1 Whale struck in the Ice and lost, Saw about 30 Whale and all large Whale Head, The Ships was not doing much in Shanter Bay, Saw the bluff of Shanter passage, Whales working that way, Saw Heavy Ice in Tailors Bay, At 6 PM Anchored in 13 fathoms Water, Washington Head bearing S.E. distant 6 mile

Wednesday July 21st

Light airs and Calm, Clear weather part of the Day, Ship at anchor, 5 Boats off whaling, Saw plenty of large whale working from Washington Head to Shanter Passage or a cross the mouth of Tailors Bay, Considerable Ice about 8 Ships in sight when clear, Whale Ship

Thursday July 22nd

First part of the Day Calm, and some clear, At 2 PM took a breeze from E.N.E. took the anchor and stood to the N and anchored off Shanter bluff, Boats all came on board, Mr Pinker lost 2 Men and a blunderbuss last night in stopping a Shore with shot, My consent and had a boat sail burnt, The Ship Monon 2^d and a Bargee laying off the bluff, Saw and heard 4 or 5 whale
