

Thursday Oct 7th

Light wind from W and fine weather, beating to the West Carrying all sail. I gamed with the Delaware and Ship Eliza Addams & other sail in sight, Saw 1 whale going N East Brockleiff Barring 10 to 15 mile

Friday Oct 8th

Light breeze from W to S and fine weather, beating towards the N Shore Saw 5 whale off Rocky point, Chased with out success, gamed with Delaware and Eliza Addams, Saw 4 Ships sailing and one a Cutting, Saw plenty of whale feede 15 mile off Rocky point Barring N.E.W.

Saturday Oct 9th

First part light wind from S.W. and fine weather, Saw 4 whale working in to the N Shore, stood in to the West Shore, Saw plenty of whale 4 mile off Shore of the River 4 Ships here Chasing hard till the after noon Latter part of the Day nearly Calm, At Dark light airs from S.E., 10 mile to the E.N.E. of Rocky point, Plenty of Whale feede in the water, Saw a Finback and some white fish

Sunday Oct 10th

Commenced with Strong wind from E.N.E. and Cloudy weather, Carrying reefed topsails, In the morning Steered off to the N.W. along the land, in Company with the Delaware, At 11 A.M. Close in to Rocky point Bay, Saw several whale in the Bay and off the point Delaware got one and gave it to the Tender Mist one, At 12 M. Ship in company, She got a whale Saw plenty of whale close in Shore 8 mile S.W. of Rocky point, Latter part of the Day more moderate

Monday Oct 11th

First part of the Day, Light wind from E.N.E. and Cloudy weather, Standing off and on Rocky point, At 4 in the morning sent 3 boats in Shore, At 11 P.M. Came on board, Saw no whale in Shore, I went on board the Delaware, the Delaware's whale hook yesterday is a 45 blb whale, At 3 P.M. blowed up a fresh gale from E.N.E. with some rain, Saw 4 whale off Shore Chased, At Dark kept the sails and stood off and on the Main land Carrying Close sails, Ship Lexington of Nantucket & K. Rayer in sight, Beromsted Down to 29th

Tuesday Oct 12th

First part of the Day Strong gale from E.N.E. and a thick rain storm, Latter part Strong gale from N.W. and Cloudy, Sea white with snow, Carrying Close reefed sails, Standing off and on the N Shore, About 15 mile N.W. of Rocky point, K. Rayer and Delaware in company, Heavy sea rolling in from E.N.E. At 6 P.M. Moderated, Weather not very cold

Wednesday Oct 13th

Strong gale from N to E.N.E. and a thick cold rain storm, Standing off and on the N Shore Carrying Close reefed sails, Delaware in company, We are not far from Rocky point At 4 P.M. Sailed Wicklesoff and Shuyersloaf Island Barring S.E.W., Saw K. Rayer to the S.E. of us, Sounded 30 fathoms water, Shore 8 mile off, At 4 wind died, took a light breeze from S.E. Heavy sea running
