

Wednesday Nov 24th

Strong trade wind from
N.E. to E. S. E. and fine weather steering S by W
Carrying all sail. Saw a large whale in the
ships wake. Took like a sperm whale. All
hands employed in washing bone. Repaired
the main hoyle

Thursday Nov 25th

Strong trade wind from E and S. W. by
Carrying all sail. The first of the day, latter part
Carrying keels topails. Splicing the main yard
Tacked & topmast standing. Hauls boom on the
main yard to secure the yard. Steering S by W
Saw 2 Pinback whales the ship. All hands
washing bone. The wind inclines to the south
ward

Friday Nov 26th

Fresh wind from E & E. and S. W. by
Some of the time, Carrying all sail. Most the time
Heaving S by W. All hands employed in washing bone
in the morning and bone. Saw nothing through
the day but a few birds.

Saturday Nov 27th

Fresh wind from S. E. and fine
Clear weather, Heaving S. S. W. and S. W. by E. Carrying
all sail. First part of the day employed in splicing
bone and standing. At 12 M. got
the chane up and went then on the anchors
and over hauled to fathoms Charing At 9 AM
Made the land to the S. E. to the S. W. At 3 PM
took the pilot. At 5 PM came to anchor in
Hilo Harbor, in 8 fathoms water and 45 fathoms
Chane out. Hilo is one of the finest looking
place on the Sandwich Islands.

Sunday Nov 28th

Light baffling winds
and rain. Laying at anchor. in the morn
ing. Most of the day & sail all hands
employed. Went to Market & got 55 lbs of Beef & 10
pounds of potatoes. Presses in here & merchandise
men in here the rest of the day

Monday Nov 29th

Light baffling winds & rain
in the morning cleared up at 8 AM. Laying
at anchor in the Harbor of Hilo. Harbord watch
ashore. Went to Market & got 80 lbs of Beef & 10
pounds of potatoes. Sent the sick men ashore. 9 sick
number. Ship Walter. Root of Edgartown went
out before 7. Watch aboard & employed in making
straps of Gunter Bone.

Tuesday Nov 30th

Light baffling winds &
good weather. First part, latter part rainy. Laying
in the port of Hilo. Harbord watch ashore
Watch aboard. Buntching Bone. Got 1 Raft
of Water off. Got 75 lbs of Beef

Wednesday Dec 1st

Good wind from S. E. &
fine weather. Laying in the Harbor of Hilo.
All hands employed in buntching Bone & stow
ing down Water in the Pice Hole. At 3 PM
commenced to rain. Dark John Wells came
in to anchor. Got 72 lbs of Beef

Thursday Dec 2nd

Good wind from N. E. and fine
weather. Laying in the Harbor of Hilo. Harbord watch
ashore. Watch aboard. Buntching Bone & making
straps. Got 104 lbs of Beef
