

Tuesday Feb 11th

Strong wind from ESE and hazy weather, Cloud with Rain, Stowed the Anchors, Mended the Chances and Unbent them and Stowed them below. Blacksmith repairing the falls to the Wind Sails, purchased falls, Carrying all Sails, Tied the fore top gallant Mast Sail, Unbent it to the keel.

Wednesday Feb 13th Lat by Red 20, 40 Long by Boat 161,00

First part of the Day. Strong wind from SE and a heavy Rain Storm, Steering W by S, Carrying all Sails. Saw nothing through the Day. Latter part of the Day wind moderate and heavy fresh Rain & Storm, Raining too hard to Carry on work.

Thursday Feb 14th Lat by Red 20, 40 Long 164, 10

First part fresh wind from S.E. Steering W by S Carrying all Sails. Latter part light wind and fine weather, Repaired the fore top gallant Sail and bent it. Finished repairing the Larboard Row Boat and put her out. Plenty of birds around the Ships. Blacksmith finished the purchase falls to Wind Sails.

Friday Feb 15th Lat by Red 21, 28 Long W by Ch 166,00

Light airs and Calm all Day. Employed in repairing Sails, Repaired up an old fore sail & repaired small top sail. Carpenter repairing the Whetner Boat, Cooper repairing Cask. Blacksmith Mending eye balls for to hold the anchors on the bows. At Ground down to the light breeze in a Squall from E Course WSW.

Lat 21, 28 Long W by Ch 166, 15

Saturday Feb 16th

Light wind from SE and fine weather, two or three Rain Squalls through the Day, Steering WSW, Carrying all Sails. Watches employed in taring the rigging and other jobs, Carpenter repairing boats, Blacksmith making Bolts, Cooper repairing Casks, Mr. Whitney painted his old Boat.

Sunday Feb 17th Lat by Red 11, 13 Long W by Ch 168, 15

Light wind from ESE and fine weather, Steering W by S by S Under all Sails, Nothing in sight.

Monday Feb 18th Lat by Red 11,00 Long which 170,5

Light variable breezes from E. & fine weather, Steering W by S. All sail set, Watches unbent the jibsail & repaired it on board at again, Cooper repairing Casks, Carpenter repairing a Boat, Blacksmith taring to black iron.

Tuesday Feb 19th Lat 10 52 Long 171,44

Light wind from E by SE and fine weather, Steering W by S Carrying all Sails. Saw nothing but birds through the Day. Unbent the Main topsail, Middle Sticks & bent on old topsail to the Main, Carpenter repairing a Boat, Cooper & Blacksmith employed at their trades.

Lat 10,50 Long W by Ch 174,00
