

Thursday March 14th

Strong wind from E. & S. E. and some squally. Steering S. by W. by W. till 12 M. then found that we were in the Latitude of Peely Island on Chart 275. I then steered off West till 1 P.M. then raised Peely Island bearing S. by W. distant about 10 miles. The Latitude of Peely Island on my Chart is not right, it is laid down to 40 North. I then hit upon the Latitude is about 26.50 North. The Longitude is all right. We run off to Peely Island then luffed to heading E. S. E. at 6.30 P.M. Peely Island bearing S. W. 5 miles. Kept the fore & main topsails and stood off and on for the night, being squally weather. Carpenter worked under the main house. Crew employed in Ships Duty.

Friday March 15th

Strong wind from E. & S. E. some hazy weather. Stood in to Peely Island in the morning. It proved to be a grassy Is. and saw Peely Island bearing S. by E. carrying all sail beating up to Peely Island. At sundown up to Peely Island. Shortened sail. I have made a mistake about the Latitude of Peely Island. I think now the Latitude of Peely Island on my Chart is all right, for yesterday I called it Peely Island Peely Island. Unhappily the old main topsail and bent a better one, repaired the old one & stowed it below. I am in hope of getting a shore in the morning.

At 6 P.M. Peely Island bearing N. W. by N. Dist 6 miles

Saturday March 16th

Light breeze from E. & S. E. and fine weather. At Daylight in the morning Peely Island bore N. W. by W. distant 15 miles. Steered off for the Island. At 11 A.M. gave order to go off the Harbor on the W. S. W. Side of the Island. A Canoe & 3 Men came along side to pilot us in. Cleared away 2 boats and went a shore with 6 bbls Salt & 1 Hogs of Tobacco and part of a Piece of red Glanel. Sold the Salt at \$5 per bbl and the tobacco at 3 1/2 ct a lb and the Glanel at 50 ct per yd. At 4 P.M. we returned to the Ship with both boats loaded with 9 bags of 8 ct a lb & 2 large Turtles \$3 Each 40 Pumpkins at the rate of \$42. Sent a messenger 13 doz Eggs at 50 ct a doz, 12 bbls Onions at \$4 per bbl 3 doz of fish at \$4 per doz, 1 doz Decid at \$4 per doz. The Onions are all green with green tops on and they gave two bbls of Onions with the tops on for one bbl or they was \$3.50 per bbl. Tobacco & Salt will always trade here. They tell me they would like to have some Seeders of all kinds. There has not been any vessel here this Season. Mr Savory is 63 years old, he has a Quam Woman for a wife about 30 years old. She has 2 small boys and 3 small girls. The oldest girl 10 year old. Mr Savory on the 10th of this month shot a man with a Pistol for forcing his little Daughter only 10 year old. This man was about 30 year old, he lived in Massachusetts and had been living with Mr Savory. Called the people to gather to consult them what to do with this man. They agreed to put him on one of the small Is. Mr Savory had told him if he had any thing to do with his Daughter before she was 16, enough to judge for her self that he would
