

Wednesday Aug 17th

First and Middle part of the Day Strong wind from W. S. W. and fine weather, 3 Boats off whaling, At 11 AM one returned, He got Lurka a whale and lost him, Bent a good Lib, fore topmast stay sail, fore top sail, Main Spencer, Mizentop sail, Spanker and a new main top sail, At 5 PM Spencer's bailing, and at 7 PM the Boats all on board, Saw one whale taken, Boats saw quite plenty of big whales in Shoal water Bay

Thursday Aug 18th

Fresh breezes from S. W. and fine weather, all the Boats off whaling, and one looking for the whale we lost yesterday, At 1 PM Saw our Dead whale, got a Boat down from over head and went off and got the whale and got him along side of Seenglaum and made him fast for the night, Saw several whales going up Bay Brutus and Arctic Cutting,

Friday Aug 19th

First part of the Day Strong wind from W. and Clear weather, Cc'tin our whale, took the anchor and worked up Bay off the Yellow bluff, Several whales taken here yesterday, Several Ships to anchor around us in the middle of the Bay, At 4 PM Came up a heavy thunder shower from N. W. with rain and hail, Employed in bailing, all the Boats on board

Saturday Aug 20th

First part of the Day light westerly wind from W. and fine weather, Sent off 4 Boats whaling, 1 Whale taken At 4 PM Took the wind from N. E. Came up a very heavy thunder storm from N. E. W. Finished bailing, One boat returned Report of seeing a humped whale up Bay

Sunday Aug 21st

First part light wind from W. and fine weather, Boats all off whaling, 1 Whale taken last night, At and plenty of whales up Bay, Carpentered repairing my boat, Latter part of the Day fresh wind from N. E. and foggy, I sent a boat to look for the late brig from Honolulu to get letters, but did not find her

Monday Aug 22nd

Light wind from N. E. and a heavy swell rolling in, and some foggy, I sent on board the brig for letters but there was no letters there for me, got a small whale and cut him in, sent the Boats up Bay again to catch a mother foggy, Several whale taken last night, about 20 Ships around here, the most of them a bailing, were laying off the Yellow bluff, in the middle of the Bay, 70 ft of water and the big anchor down

Tuesday Aug 23rd

First part fresh wind from W. and Clear weather, 5 Boats off whaling, Saw 5 whales taken and heard of more, Latter part light wind 1 Boats came to the ship Report plenty of whales up Bay but can't catch them, Cooper repairing cash Carpentered repairing a boat, Black some the day, fine
