

Wednesday Aug 14th

Light wind from SE and good weather, Employed in Bailing, Yesterday Mr. Walcott came onboard and told me that his boatsman John Simpson would go out at a whale when he had a good chance to fasten to him and he has made 1 Spear-whale, for this reason I broke him on the 23rd, 1 Boat came onboard and reported plenty of whales up Bay, but can't catch them, several whales taken to day, about 15 ships in the Bay, Mr. Lewis struck a whale and drew

Thursday Aug 15th

Light westerly wind and fine weather, All the boats of Whaling, At 6 Mr. Brunk came onboard reported plenty of whales but can't catch one, Mr. Fish came onboard from the vesper reported plenty of whales, the first of the Lucerne on the North Shore on they have got their blubber room full of 3 large whales, We finished Bailing, 4 whale taken, about 20 ships in the head of this Bay

Friday Aug 16th

Strong westerly wind and clear weather, Got a whale and got him along side at Seendown, broke out the main hold and commenced spearing down, Saw whale up Bay and S. End, the Day

Saturday Aug 17th

Strong gale from W and clear weather, All the boats onboard, Hauled down 217 bbls of oil and Cutra our whale, All the ships dragged off about 14 the breasting, and Cincinnati, Saw 2 whale taken past the ship

Sunday Aug 18th

Fresh breezes from WSW and fine weather, At 12 last night 5 boats went off whaling, Mr. Whitney got a whale and got him along side of 10 Bell, Employed in Bailing, Several whales taken, vesper Boat came along side, The most of the ships have stood over in school water Bay, A Native Canoe came along side, with 4 men, 1 boy and 1 woman, I bought some fish of them, They left and went onboard the vernal

Monday Aug 19th

Light wind from WSW and fine weather, This morning I Cutra our whale and sent off the 2 boats, Employed in Bailing, The vesper Boat came along side, they can't find the vesper, I told them to bring their whale along side, The Montezuma and I would cut him in, At Seendown Mr. Silva brought a whale along side, got him yesterday, Saw plenty of whales on the South Shore yesterday

Tuesday Aug 20th

Strong Wind from WSW and clear weather, In the morning we Cutra our whale and commenced Bailing and cleared up the docks, 3 boats off whaling, Saw several whales breaching and spearing up Bay, Saw one whale taken, Sent down the main top gallant mast
