

Sunday Oct 2nd

First part of the Day light breeze from N.E. on baffling, Cloudy weather, Flying to work in to N.E. Harbor, Saw the Harrison anchored off Stepped bluff, Latter part of the Day light airs from N.W. and Snow on Rain. At 6 P.M. Came to anchor in N.E. Harbor in 11 fathoms of water with the big anchor and reefed the topsails and furled the sails raised a light for the Harrison to see, Saw several whale off the Harbor working up Bay.

Monday Oct 3rd

Fresh wind from N.W. and fine clear weather, Laying in N.E. Harbor, At 11 A.M. took the anchor, set sail and stood up Bay, Saw whales off Stepped bluff and off N.E. Harbor but going, Saw plenty of whales off Yellow bluff in the middle of the Bay, Night over took us so I stood out to the N.E. Ship Harrison in by the Sand Spit she got a whale yesterday off the Stepped bluff, Saw no other vessel in South West Bay, At Sun down the wind died and heeled to the N.E. and came up cloudy, Heave, Severe holeing in from E.S.E. All hands Employed through the Day in Cleaning bone, Carpenter made a topmast Studing Sail boom.

Tuesday Oct 4th

Blowing a heavy gale from S.E. on a thick Rain storm, In the morning off the hook, stood over to Double reefed topsail bluff then run down to, to N.E. Harbor and anchored At 12 M. the Harrison Came in to anchor, She lost an anchor in the Bay to Day, I went on board the Harrison, her boats came down from the Sand Spit to Day and reported there being plenty of Whales.

Wednesday Oct 5th

Strong wind from W and Clear weather, Laying in N.E. Harbor, sent up Bay 3 boats, a whaling, sent aloft the main top gall and mast, Carpenter making Studing Sail boom, Capt Denis came on board and took dinner with me.

Thursday Oct 6th

Strong gales from N.W. and Cold clear weather, 3 boats up Bay a whaling, and the Harrison had 3 boats up Bay, I went on shore a gunning, saw plenty of Ducks, did not get any, Employed on board in Cleaning bone, I went on board the Harrison and took supper with the Capt Denis, The wind went down with the Sun The Moon shines pleasant.

Friday Oct 7th

Strong wind from N.W. and Clear Cold weather, 3 boats up Bay, At Daylight in the morning took the anchor set sail and run up to Schooner Harbor, Saw several whales in Schooner Harbor working up Bay, Anchored in Schooner Harbor in 7 fathoms of water, furled the sails lowered 2 boats for the whales, At 12 M. all the boats came on board, Carpenter went on shore and cut a stick for a Royal yard, Saw some white fish.

Saturday Oct 8th

Strong wind from N.W. and Bugged, In the morning sent the boats in to Schooner Harbor, Saw no whales there, they came on board, Took the anchor and stood out the Bay, then locked and stood back, Saw 2 whales.
