Fresh wind from N.W. and
Rain squalls, steering E. Under all sail,
Carried away a topmast Studding sail Boom
and lost the Boom iron over board. Watches
Employed in washing bone. An old & small
sperm North makes the ship hole Chad

Set by 47, 02 Long E by Ch 165, 8
Saturday Oct 12th

Fresh wind from W and Rain
squalls, steering E and E by S. Carrying all sail
Studding sails set, blew nothing through the deck
but the blue Ocean, the Sun and blue sky and
flying clouds and some sea birds. Watches
employed in washing bones. Ship colony had
with 2 N.W. small

Set 46, 16 North Long about 168 E
Sunday Oct 13th

Fresh wind from W and squ-
ally weather, steering E & E by S. Carrying
all sail. Dried our bone and stowed it
below, and got some on deck to
soak. Saw several finbacks, and some
birds. Observation

Monday Oct 14th

Fresh wind from N.W. and fine
weather, steering E by S. Carrying all sail,
Watches employed in washing bones. Black
smith making a boom iron. Cooper has
made me a nice tub. Saw nothing but
plenty of birds hovering around the mast
heads.

Set by 43, 40 Long, E by Ch 176,

Tuesday Oct 15th

Fresh wind from N and
fine weather, steering E. Carrying all sail,
Began washing the bone, Dried it all and
stowed it below.

Set by 42, 18 Long West 178, 44

Tuesday Oct 15th

Commences with light air from
N and good weather. All hands employed in wash-
ing ship and mast. Latter part of the day a rain
sprung up from S.E. with rain. First part
of the day steering E. At sundown heading E & S

Set about 41, 50 Long about 147, 10
Wednesday Oct 16th

Commences with a fresh
gale from E by S. Carrying close reefed top-
sails, heading N by E. At 9 all main deck and
sheeped deck to W.S.W. and below strong and
cleared off. At 11 all moderated some so all
sail, steering E by S. At 5 P.M. wind died and
the larks in the gullion sails, At 6 P.M. wind
came out in a squall from N.W. Called
all hands and close reefed the topsails and
furled the courses, heading E by S. Wash-
ed out 2 boats, and cleaned off the Caboose
At day break in the West when the Sun
set
