

Wednesday Feb 5th

Strong wind from S to S.W. and kugged weather, At 11 A.M. got the whale along side, At 8 in the morning, Hoisted the Chane, made Sail with the whale in tow, After Carrying Sail & tearing ship several times in thick rain & squally, we came to anchor in Turtle Bay with our whale along side, I went along on board the George & Mary

Thursday Feb 16th

First part Strong wind from S.W. kugged weather, In the morning we left in our whale and started the works, Latter part of the day wind from N. & better weather, Left Greene, Longwin, Comstock & Elmore came to see me

Friday Feb 17th

Fresh wind from N.W. & an old swell on, In the morning we got under way and stood out of Turtle Bay and then down to the bluff where we slipped our anchor, tried to get our Chane by the Bay rope, but could not, being so much sea on, In the afternoon sent our boats in shore whaling, At sundown they came on board, stood off & on through the night, Saw quite plenty of whales going S.W.

Saturday Feb 18th

First part of the day light wind from S.W. and good weather, In the morning sent 4 boats in shore whaling, At 11 A.M. we took in sail and got our Chane to the windward, Sent more boats whaling, Saw plenty of whales

going north quite fast, At night quite kugged,

Sunday Feb 19th

Strong gales from W. & W. and a Cheaney sea with squally, Put the cutting blocks & fall on the Chane, main mast, Ease the Chane & anchor, Stop prebaking Cheaney, Boats on board got an observation gone 20 mile too far East

Monday Feb 20th

First part Moderate wind from S.W. and a big swell on, Sent 4 boats in shore whaling, Latter part of the day strong wind from W. & kugged weather, Boats came on board

Tuesday Feb 21st

Commences with light wind from S.W. In the morning we took the anchor off whale rock, set all sail & steered for the Sandwich Islands, Latter part of the day strong wind from W. & S.W. Heading S.W. by W, Stowed the anchors & Chanes, The Chain top gallant backstay ported, & placed it & set the back stays up, Started from N. at 27, 33 & 40 and Long 114, 40

Wednesday Feb 22nd

Moderate wind from S.W. & W. and cloudy weather, Steering W.S.W. Under all sail, Stowed down our ail in the fore hole in the main, Cleared up the decks ready for washing off
