Monday Feb 17th

Fresh wind from E.N.E. and fine weather, Steering W.S. W. Carrying all Sail, Watches employed on the rigging, Took in the 5th boat, Repaired her and put her over haul.

Tuesday Feb 18th

Moderate wind from E.N.E. to E.N.E. and good weather, Steering W.S. W. Carrying all Sail, Watches employed on the rigging, Pulling the rigging, Painted the Boats over head

Lat 14, 35 Long 136, 30

Wednesday Feb 19th

Moderate wind from E.N.E. and some rain squalls, Steering W.S. W. Carrying all Sail, Watches employed on the rigging & in making Spungorm, got some Dried to put Potatoes in, the Weather & Humidity is worse again

Strong gales from E.N.E. and keeged weather, Steering W.S. W. Carrying all Sail, Carried away the main Mast yard and sent a new one aloft, Employed on the rigging & making Spungorm Lat 12, 3 Long 148, 40
