At 11 P.M. last night raised the land Run

fine weather, Laid off & on with the ship
got off 80 bbls of potatoes at \$3.50 per bbl &
a quarter of beef, then we steered for
Karakakoa Bay for wood

Light variable wind and cloudy
trying to get to Karakakoa Bay, In 5 miles
of the point at Seendown, Mr Huntley sent
get any better, Set S 12 N 17, 40

Thursday March 8th

This morning I
pulled a shore to Karakakoa Bay, I see
if I could get wood but could not so I
steered off to the N.W. with light S.W. wind
D. Saw a ship towing in to Karakakoa Bay
Saw a schooner & plenty of canoes along the coast
At 6 P.M. we took the trade wind, heading
N.W. by W, too late for oranges at Karakakoa

Friday March 9th

Strong trades and clear
weather, Arrived at Honolulu at 3 P.M.
I went a shore & got my letters and looked
at Mr Huntley's shore & trunk, At 5
P.M. returned to the ship

Saturday March 10th

Strong trades and fine
weather, Ship laying off and on at Honolulu
At 8 A.M. Mr Homer with a boat crew went a
shore, Shipped my second mate as first mate
and shipped Mr Sylva for second mate, At
5 P.M. I and boat crew came on board
Discharged Mr Huntley & Flood Sick

Sunday March 11th

Fresh trades and fine weather
Then, Laying off & on at Honolulu, Carrying
keels & topbills, At 10 A.M. Mr Homer
came along side in a shore boat & Mr
pealers went a shore to see his wife

Strong trades and fine weather
Ship laying off & on, In the morning I
went a shore with my boat crew, Shipped 4 men
At 4, 30 P.M. I came off to the ship with my
