

Boats Crew and the 5 men I shipped,
Set all sail & Steered off to the West for
Attorney for wood, got an Alitude yome
us 20 mile to far East of the land

Tuesday March 13th
Strong trade wind. This
morning we stoped at Atot and got off 6
Cord~~at~~ loads of wood, then Steered off for
the next Island to the West to get some
logs, the Island to the West 6 mile as Sordolen
Set off and on through the night. This after
noon had light bafflin wind to the lee of
the Island

Wednesday March 14th
Strong wind from N.E. &
fine weather. At 7 this morning sent 3
boats ashore to Nihau to trade for logs. The
natives wanted part money, so the boats
did not trade, they came to the ship, then we
steered off to the N.W. S. Steamed the anchor
and chains, got up a topsail to repair
Thursday March 15th

Strong trades and fair weather
Steering N.W. by S. Carrying all sail, Finished
repairing the good chain topsail and bent it
or bed around the water ways on the Starboard
Side

Set by, 21, 38 Long by, Ch 164, 33
Friday March 16th

Fresh trades and good weather, Steer-
ing N.W. by S. Carrying all sail at the main, fore-
topsail, fore & close reefed. Repairing a topsail
worked along the plank sheer on the Starboard Side,
Saw a Fishback

Saturday March 17th

Moderate trade wind & some
rain squalls, Steering N.W. by S. Carrying all sail
at the main. Watcher employed in repairing
a topsail & making Spinnaker.

Set by, 21, 48 Long by, Ch 170, 41
Sunday March 18th

Moderate wind from E.S.E.
and cloudy, some rain through the night.
Steering N.W. by S. Carrying all sail to the main,
Saw nothing through the day, Mr. Sealers is
getting better

Set by, 21, 50
Monday March 19th
Moderate wind from E. to
E.S.E., part the time good weather, then a
threatning squall of rain & lightning.
All sail set at the main, Steering N.W. by S.
Saw a Fishback, Watcher employed in re-
pairing an old topsail, Saw a Fishback
Set by, 21, 55 Long by, Ch 176, 8

Tuesday March 20th
Fresh wind from E.S.E. on
rain squalls, Steering N.W. by S. Carrying all
sail at the main, Finished the topsail & bent
it forward. Sent down the allizen galled yard
& mast, raised the allizen topmast up on the fell
in a new fid
