2 Hard pine Boards, 36 feet, I gave him an order
on C N Williams & Co for the same at Honolulu

June 14th Capt Allen Ship Onward let me have on
oak Plank 8 feet long 16 inches wide and 2 in
thick, gave him an order on C N Williams

June 16th Capt Molly Ship Thomas & Co
let me have 53 feet of Hard pine
Sceding Sluff & I gave him an order on
C N Williams for the same

Right Whale taken on the 2nd land by Eliza & Ma
Son Last of Feb & March 1859

Let from 46 to 48 South
from 168 to 170 East
Mostly in Long 170 East near the Snair
traps, in sight of the Southern part of 83
& Along to the South of Scarop Bay
