At 11 AM commenced to rain, repaired the
main topgallant Sail & bent it, Bent the
Fore top gallant Sail & bent it, Saw some
Kellers & a Sulphur bottom, Cooper finished
putting Chocky around the Rudder head

Saturday April 14th

Commences with strong
wind from E. S. E. and a thick Rain Storm
Steering S. Carrying all Sail, At 4 PM wind
hauled to E. and blowed on, Stook in the
gallant Sails & reefed the topsails, Latter
part of the Day fresh wind from E. and a th-
ick Rain Storm, Steering S. Under Double
reefed topsails, At 12 AM wind E. S. E.
No obs Lat by acc about 44.30

Sunday April 15th

Commences with strong wind
from E. S. E. Steering S. Carrying reefed topsails
At 2 PM wind S. E. Heading S. S. W. Thick Rain
Storm, At 4 PM wind hauled to S. S. E. Wore ship
Heading S. in to a head Sea Wore to under Saub-
le reefed main topsail, Stay sails & main Spencer
During the night the wind hauled to S. S. W., At
6 AM made Sail. Heading S. E. Thick weather
with Rain & Snow, Cold weather

Sat by obs 44.08 Long about 154 East

Monday April 16th

First part of the Day strong
wind from S. S. W. & a thick Rain Storm, Heading
S. E. Carrying Double reefed topsails, Heavy swell
from S. E. The wind moderated through the
night. At 4 AM wore ship Heading S. by S. At
6 AM wore ship Heading S. E. Latter part of the
day Calm, Clewed up the gallant Sails & Settle
ed the topsails Down on the Cap, Middle Sticked
the main Spencer, Set up the Lib. Stay & Fore
top gallant back Stays, Latter part of the Day
fine weather

Sat by obs 44.24 Long E by Ch 155.6
Tuesday April 17th

First & Middle part of the Day
Calm & fine weather, Sails Settled Down on the Cap,
repaired & Middle Sticked the Spencer, repaired an
old staysail, Cooper spliced the Fly Libboom, At 11
AM took a breeze from W. Set all Sail, Heading
S. S. W. Saw a gam of Black Fish

Sat by obs 44.36 Long E by Ch 155.10
Wednesday April 18th

First part of the Day fresh breeze
from W. to S. W. by W. Heading to the Northward. Carrying
all Sail, fine weather, Ripped out the Fly Libboom
and set up the rigging, Latter part of the Day fresh
wind from W. S. W. Heading S. Carrying all Sail, At
12 AM wind hauled to S. W. by W. Steered S. W., Bent the
Fly Lib and set it. Saw some Kelp, Water Clear
Sat by obs 46.15 Long E by Ch 154.53

Thursday April 19th

First part of the Day strong wind
from W. S. W. and good weather, Steering S. W. Carrying
reefed topsails At sundown moderated, Made Sail
Latter part of the night Calm & Cloudy. At 1 AM
took a breeze from S. W. At 4 AM took a fresh wind from
S. E. Steered S. S. W. Carrying all Sail, At 9 AM saw
