

Cape Ukoz North view

Friday Oct 3rd

First part of this Day (blowed a heavy gale from S.W. and a hard rain storm, a heavy swell rolling in under the Cape & heavy squalls came down off the land, laying to anchor with the small anchor. Latter part of the Day Calm and cloudy with rain, All hands stowing down ail in the fore peak.

Rocky point

Saturday Oct 6th

First part of this Day Calm and a thick rain storm, All hands stowing down ail in the fore peak, Latter saw a ship off the Cape. Latter part of this Day strong wind from S.W. and clear weather, At 6 in the morning took the anchor and steered to the S.W. for Rocky point to get some spars, Saw the Dutch barge standing to the S.E.

Sunday Oct 7th

Strong gales from S.W. and cloudy weather. At 5 P.M. came to anchor under Rocky point in 10 fathoms water, I went on board the Russian Brig. Latter part of the Day 4 boats crews a shore cutting spars, Saw plenty of Ducks at the mouth of the River.

Monday Oct 8th

Strong wind from S.W. and clear & cold weather, the land white with snow, The first part of this Day laying to anchor under Rocky point 4 boats crew got off some spair spars, Shot a mess of Ducks, The Russian Brig left for Fichlestop Harbor, At 6 A.M. we took the anchor and started to the S.E. along the land, Saw Whales close in to the point, lowered the boats for them, Squally off the land carrying keel & topsails.

Aian Harbor

Tuesday Oct 9th

Strong wind from S.W. and clear, cold weather, First part of the Day standing to the S.E. along shore for Aian, At 7 A.M. came to anchor at Aian & I went on shore, sent out the fly jibboom & bent the 16 main keyl and sent the yard aloft, sent the fore & Mizzen galls and yards aloft and bent the sails, 2 Dutch barges on the Russian barge in here to anchor, Saw a bowhead.

Wednesday Oct 10th

Strong wind from S.W. and fair weather, Montezuma to anchor at Aian, finished setting up the gallant rigging & bent the light sails, Took the spair anchors off the bows and stowed them below, got off 6 boat loads of wood. Montezuma is about ready to start for the Islands.

Thursday Oct 11th

Strong wind from S.W. and fine clear weather, First part of the Day finished stowing away the spair anchors & wood & got the ship all ready for sea, At daylight A.M. took the anchor, set sail and steered out to sea & hauled out of the sea, spoke ship Harrison, saw another ship & a brig beating in to Aian, stowed the anchors & hooked the starboard bow & mast boats.

Sat by obs 56, 12 Long by Ch 14920

Friday Oct 12th

Strong wind from north and fine weather. First part of the Day steering E by S through the reef, At 10 steered E & S. Latter part of the Day steering E & by E carrying all sail, set the fore topmast sliding sail. Took in the mast boat & starboard bow boat, stowed the chanes. Cleared a head of bones, set up the fore gallant backstays. At 10 P.M. saw Cape Elizabeth. Sat by obs 54, 12 Long by Ch 14410.
