

Bound out of the Sea

Saturday Oct 13th

Fresh breeze from N.W. and good weather, Steering S.E. by E. Carrying all Sail, Studing Sails Sat. Watches employed Cleaning off the Rymarks, Dried a Head of Bone and Stowed it below

Sunday Oct 14th Lat N by obs 53, 15 Long E by Ch 147, 15

First part of this Day, fresh breeze from W. and fine weather, Steering S.E. by E. Cleared of the Rymarks & Whitewashed them, Latter part of this Day light breeze from S.W. and fine weather, Steering S.E., Carrying all Sail

Monday Oct 15th Lat N by obs 51, 48 Long E by Ch 149, 40

First part of this Day light breeze from S.W. and good weather, Steering S.E. All sail Sat. At night put a lot of Bone on deck to soak for washing, Latter part of the Day Strong wind from N.W. and blowing on, Came down to whole topsails, Steering E.S.E. Watch washing Bone,

Tuesday Oct 16th Lat N by obs 50, 50 Long E by Ch 152, 50

First part of this Strong wind from N.W. Steering E.S.E. At 5 PM Close reefed the top sails and luffed by the wind, Howled a gale from N.W. through the night, Standing upon opposite tacks, At Day light in the morning Steered off S.E. by E. and set Single reefed topsails, blowed hard in Squalls from N.W. to W.N.W. At 11 AM raised the Island in Parmashure passage bearing E.S.E. & Saw a Barque a head of us, Steered around to the South of this Island

Lat by obs 49, 32 Long by Ch 154, 27

In the North Pacific Ocean

Wednesday Oct 17th

Strong westerly gales and squalls, First part of the Day, Steered around to the South of the Island that lies on side of the fifty passage, between the Rock to the S.W. of the Island & the Island & then hauled to the North & Steered out of Parmashure passage to the Pacific Ocean by Dark, Barque in Company, John Wells & thirty, Through the night & latter part of the Day Steering E. Carrying all Sail, Washing Bone

Thursday Oct 18th Lat N by obs 49, 27

Fresh gales from W. and Clear weather, Steering E. Carrying all Sail, Watches employed in washing & Drying Bone

Friday Oct 19th

First part of the Day Moderate wind from N.W. and good weather but Cloudy, Steering E. Latter part of the Day Fresh wind from S.E. and foggy & Rain heading E by S & E.S.E. Carrying whole topsails, Watches employed in washing Bone,

Saturday Oct 20th

First part of the Day light wind from S.E. and a thick Rain storm, heading E.S.E. Carrying reefed topsails, Latter part of the Day Moderate wind from S.W. and foggy & Cloudy, Steering E. Carrying whole topsails, Watches employed in washing Bone, Plenty of gulls following the ship

Sunday Oct 21st

Fresh wind from S.W. and Rain Squalls, Steering E. Carrying all sail part of the time & part the time whole topsails, Plenty of birds following the ship

Lat N by obs 49, 28 Long E by Ch 173, 34
