Wednesday Nov 14th

First part of the Day Moderate wind from E and good weather, At 1 P.M. I got on board, Ship Close in shore to the East of the 10 mile, Steered off to the N.W. to the N. of Oahu, Latter part of the Day Moderate wind from S.E. Steering to the N.W. along to the N. of Oahu, Made in sight 2 mile to the N. S. of the

Thursday Nov 15th

First part of this day fresh breeze from S.S.E. and good weather, Steering S.W. by W. along to the N. of Oahu, Latter part of the Day strong gale from S and hard Rain Squalls, Carrying keel's top sails & courses, Beating to the S.W. to the N. of Oahu, one Barge & 1 Ship in company,

Friday Nov 16th

First part of this day strong gale from S to S.S.W. and heavy Rain Squalls, Beating to the S, Carrying keel's top sails, 2 Ships in company, At 8 P.M. the main died and hauled out to the N.W. in a squall, Steered to the S.W. for Simon point, Latter part of the Day light wind from W and fine weather, Beating to the W. for Honolulu Carrying all sail, 5 Ships in company, Simon dead to N.W. distant 8 mile Tookt Capt Balcock the pilot on board

Saturday Nov 17th

First part of the Day beating to the West for Honolulu, Carrying all sail, Pilot on board, A fresh breeze from W.N.W. and fine weather, At 5 P.M. tookt in sail & the Steamer boat hooked on to us and towed us in to Honolulu Harbor & Anchored at 6 P.M. The ship left and went on shore

In Port At Honolulu

Saturday Nov 17th (Clevel day in port)

Light variable wind and fine weather, Crew on board employed in working ship, Let the Delaware have a 4 Mls Cost of Hard Coal & 100 Annel, got some fresh Meats & some potatoes from Market, Frank Butcher & David Rogers, Cooke & Mr. Humes not on board to work

Sunday Nov 18th

Light variable wind and fine weather, All hands on shore on liberty, 2 men on board the ship looking out for the ship, Montezuma anchored in Honolulu Harbor

Monday Nov 19th

Light Southerly wind and Rainy weather, Crew employed on board, got a raft of water off from shore and hoisted it on board, Mr. Lyba went before the Council to get his Discharge, Ship's 2 men got some fresh meat from Market

Tuesday Nov 20th

Light trades and fine weather, Montezuma in Honolulu Harbor, Crew on board in getting off fresh water, Tookt on board 20 lbs beef, 16 1/2 lbs bread, 12 lbs of flour, 2 bags of beans, some Sugar

Wednesday Nov 21st

Light trade wind and fine weather, The Master of the Crew on board employed in getting the ship ready for sea, Montezuma in Honolulu Harbor, Ship's 8 men & 1 Boat Steer
