

Honolulu Harbor

Thursday Nov 21st

Light trade wind and fair weather, Montezuma in Honolulu Harbor, Crew employed in Stowing down water & getting the ship ready for sea, got some fresh beef

Friday Nov 22nd

Light trade wind and fair weather, Montezuma in Honolulu Harbor, Crew employed in getting off some water & stowing it betwixt decks. Took aboard all the Ship's Stores & took aboard 40 bbls of fresh potatoes, received some fresh provisions from market, Discharged some of the Seasoners and shipped some men for the voyage, Men employed in Coaking the ship

Saturday Nov 23rd

Light S.E. trade wind and fine weather, Montezuma in Honolulu Harbor, Took aboard 20 bbls of fresh potatoes, Crew employed in Ship's Duty, then that is on board, Discharge most all the crew by the Season, Shipped Mr Jennings for first Mate, Several Carpenters employed in Coaking the ship's mast, and their seams open

Sunday Nov 24th

Strong trade wind and fine weather, Montezuma moored in Honolulu Harbor, got off some fresh provisions or beef, the Seasoners all discharged but 2 men, Crew belonging to the ship on shore on liberty

Monday Nov 25th

Strong trades and rain squalls, aired the sails, Coakers employed in Coaking the Montezuma Crew employed in Ship's Duty,

Tuesday Nov 26th

Strong trades from S.E. and rain squalls, Montezuma in Honolulu Harbor, Crew on shore on liberty, Coakers employed in Coaking the Montezuma & they finished at night, Mr Jennings (the first officer) on board

Wednesday Nov 27th

Strong S.E. trade wind and good weather, In the morning took the anchors and hauled the ship over on the weather side of the Harbor, At 10 o'clock the Pilot & Harbor Master came on board and finished hauling ship, All hands on board ready for sea, At 1 P.M. set sail and went out of the Harbor, At 2 P.M. the Captain & Pilot left the ship for the shore, Took the anchors on the bows & stood off & on through the night

Thursday Nov 28th Sea Day

First part of the day, Strong S.E. trade wind & good weather, All hands on board & the Pilot on board, At 1 P.M. set sail & went out of the Harbor, At 2 P.M. the Captain & the Pilot left the ship for the shore, Montezuma laid off and on Honolulu through the night, Took the anchors on the bows, Latter part of the day light wind from S.E. and good weather, Montezuma beating up to Honolulu, all sail set
