Wednesday Dec 5<sup>th</sup>

Fresh breeze from E.N.E. to E.S.E. and some Rain Squalls, Heading from S.W. to S.E. Carrying all sail, All hands on deck, Smoking ship, Saw a ship to the S.W. of us, Heading to the S

Thursday Decem 6<sup>th</sup>

Fresh breeze from E.S.E. to S.E. and Rain Squalls, Heading from N.E. to E.S.E. all sail set, Smoking ship, At 2 A.M. opened the hatches,
