it.

Studding Sail Booms, Cooper making a Topmast
Studding Sail Boom, Lat N by Ob 32, 15 Long by Ch 149, 21

Thursday Decem 13th

Strong gales from S.W. and
some Squally, Steering E & E, Carrying all Sail,
Watchers employed on the kepping, Cooper making
Topmast Studding Sail Booms.

Friday Decem 14th

Fresh wind from S.W. to W. and
good weather, Steering E & E. Carrying all Sail &
Studding Sails, Watchers employed in repairing old
Sails, Cooper put the spades on the handles & repairing
the wheel blocks.

Lat by Ob 31, 35 Long by Ch 141, 46

Saturday Decem 15th

First part of the day Strong wind
from S.W. and Rain, Steering E & E Carrying all Sail,
Sent aloft the Cutting pendants, Latter part of the
day Strong wind from W.

Sunday Decem 16th

Fresh breeze from W. and fine weather,
steering E & E. Carrying all Sail, Saw 2 Finbacks.
