

Thursday Jan 10th

Light wind from S.E. the first part of the Day and Cloudy. Latter part rainy & blew fresh from E. 3 Boats off whaling, Saw quite plenty of whale, Ship Europa got one, We started at 2 Under water, Employed in board in stowing oil in the Mizen hold, Joseph Phene is here, Carpenter of New England has finished our boat & Done it well

Friday January 11th

Last night blowed a gale from S.E. and a thick rain storm, At 5 this morning the Europa Drayed Close under our Bow, Put the Cutting Yalls on the Chane & got ready for stopping through the Day Strong wind from W.N.W. and Rugged 4 Boats off whaling, Saw but few whales, The New England got one, Broke out for Shooke head & Shooke, Saw another ship off shore, Paid the Carpenter \$10, for repairing the Boat

Saturday January 12th

Fresh breeze from N.W. and fine weather, 4 Boats off whaling, Saw plenty of whales, but they dont strepe in to the Kelp, I went half way to Shamings lagoon, Saw some whales along shore, and some Kelp on the farther point, A Schooner passed here to Day with Onions & Potatoes

Sunday January 13th

Strong winds from W.N.W. and Rugged weather, 4 Boats off whaling, Saw but few whales, got the New England, Black Smith to the new palls to the Windlapp, The Joseph Phene left here this after noon & The Robbin Hood touched here this after noon

On the Coast of California

Monday Jan 14th

Strong wind from N.W. to N. and Rugged weather, After noon sent 4 Boats in shore a whaling, Saw plenty of whales and some of them come through the Kelp, started 4 one, the New England Boat faster to one, Blacksmith finished the Windlapp palls, paid him \$3,

Tuesday Jan 15th

Fresh wind from W.N.W. and fine weather, 5 Boats off whaling, Saw plenty of whales, going South & 3 or 4 going North, The Bomber 3. Whale & the Electra bombed, New England got a whale last night, Saw a Schooner pass to the North, Saw a Ship to the South off Scrag point

Wednesday Jan 16th

Strong gale from W.N.W. and some rain squalls, A big sea was laying with a Cutting Yall & stopper on the Chane Ship pitching heavily & rolling & the spray flying over the ship, Saw some Sevel fresh going South, All hands onboard, Ship New England & Electra laying here

Thursday Jan 17th

Calm and fine weather 5 Boats off whaling, Saw plenty of whale off shore going South, Electra bombed a whale and got our whale that Drifted a shore
