

Off Point Ujena Or

Monday Feb 18th

Light westerly wind and fine weather, 4 boats off whaling, Saw a great show of whales going North, Close in to the Point & around to the East of the rocks, in the night, Whales Close in to the Kelp and going slow, Bombed 4 Whales & Did not Catch any, Electrica got a whale & had a boat badly stove

Tuesday Feb 19th

Light variable wind and fine weather, 4 boats off whaling, Saw a great number of whales going North off Point Eugenia Close in to the Kelp, Bombed a whale around in the night on the point of Kelp on the Green, Bombed another off point Eugenia, Electrica bombed 2 whales & Did not Catch them, Lots of whale bring too and gin & breach Close in to point Eugenia

Wednesday Feb 20th

Fresh wind from West some Rugged, 4 boats off whaling, Bombed one whale & got the Sunken whale to the ship, Saw quite plenty of whale going North, Electrica bombed a whale and one boat struck 2 whales at a time and cut from one & saved one, Manuel Boat Steer, Liffey to Day

Thursday Feb 21st

Light Westerly wind and fine weather, Cut our whale & started the work, 3 boats in shore a whaling, Bombed 2 whales & think we sunk one, Saw plenty of whales going North in gangs, Electrica got a whale & picked up one of her bombed whales, A boat Come up here from Turtle Bay and a keelaway Boat Ball here bound over to Cerros Island

Natividad Island

Friday Feb 22nd

First part of the day Calm & fine weather, Employed in sailing, 3 boats off whaling, Saw a great show of whales going North, Struck a large whale & Killed him 20 mile to the S.W. of here, Towed a while, found that was going away from the ship, so I let the whale go & Came to the ship we pulled from Sundown till 3 in the morning before we got to the ship, Electrica got her 11th whale, Latter part of the Day Strong wind from W.S.W.

Saturday Feb 23rd

First part of the Day light breeze from S.E. and good weather, Latter part strong wind from W.S.W. and Rugged, 4 boats off whaling, Saw a few whale going North

Sunday Feb 24th

Strong gales from W.S.W. and Rugged weather, All hands on board, Employed in stowing down 79 bbls of oil in the fore hold, Saw a Steamer going South

Monday Feb 25th

First part of the Day fresh breeze Calm and fine weather, Latter part of the Day fresh breeze from W.S.W. and Rugged, 4 boats off whaling, Saw several gangs of whales Close in shore but made no chance for striking

Tuesday Feb 26th

Commenced with light air and Calm, and good weather 4 boats off whaling, Saw several gangs of whales going to the East Close in shore, At 10 A.M. blowed up strong from W.S.W. and Rugged, boats Came to the ship, Latter part of the Day, Took our bone out of the fore hold & stowed it down in the Allizen Hatch
