

## In Turtle Bay

Friday March 8<sup>th</sup>

Light wind from N.E. and fine weather. In the morning we took the anchor at Point Eugenia and run down to Turtle Bay. At 5 P.M. came to anchor along side the Electra in Turtle Bay in Cyathums water, 8 ships in here, 2 of them a sailing and one a cutting.

Saturday March 9<sup>th</sup>

Light wind from N.E. and fine weather, 3 boats off whaling, saw a very few whale, Healed the ship and coaled the Harbor hands, The Schooner came in from California

Sunday March 10<sup>th</sup>

Strong wind from S.E. and rugged weather, 3 boats off whaling saw plenty of whale going north, one whale taken & 2 struck. Bought of Capt. Moorefield 70 sacks of Irish potatoes at \$2.25 and 4 sacks of beets \$4, 4 sacks, 54 sacks turnips at \$4.00 per sack & 4 sacks of cabbage at \$4.00 per sack.

Monday March 11<sup>th</sup>

Strong wind out side and fine weather, 3 boats off whaling, saw 2 gangs of whale going north, Healed the ship over on the Harbor hands, and scraped off the grass, Met the hold

Tuesday March 12<sup>th</sup>

Strong wind from W. and rugged weather, 3 boats off whaling, saw a few whale & 2 whale struck and lost the barque, Capt. Fisher left here for the Islands, We blocked the Harbor hands

## In Turtle Bay

Wednesday March 13<sup>th</sup>

Fresh wind from S.E. and fine weather, 2 boats off whaling, saw a very few whale going north, Part of the ships have no boats off, Broke out the cash between decks and got ready for taking the Electra's oil

Thursday March 14<sup>th</sup>

Strong wind from S.E. and fine weather, waiting for the Electra's oil, 3 boats off whaling, saw quite plenty of whale going north, Ship Charles W. Hagen got a whale, Capt. Brown and Capt. Fish spent the evening with me

Friday March 15<sup>th</sup>

Fresh breeze from the northward and fine weather, Montezuma in Turtle Bay, I have knocked off whaling, Took on board 144 lbs of the Electra's oil on freight of 6 Cts per gallon & 5 per ct primage & I have down some of our water, Let the Electra have some cash in shacks

Saturday March 16<sup>th</sup>

Light wind from the S.E. and fine weather, Stowed down our oil and cleared up the decks, All hands on board

Sunday March 17<sup>th</sup>

Light wind from S.E. and fine weather, Nothing a doing on board, The Electra left here for the Islands, I went on board the Europa, The Europa got a whale, See about 20 to 30 whale a day pass here to the north, Capt. Fish and Cornet came on board here
