

At Cape St Lucas

Some wood from shore, The water in kitchen, well
is first rate water

Thursday March 28th

First part of the Day Calm,
Middle part of the Day light wind from S.W., Latter
part of the Day light wind from S.W. and through
the night light wind from off the land, Cool throu-
gh the night and light warm through the Day, got
off 1 bullock, 25 Cash water, 4 bags beans, 3 shavings
oars and 6 cords wood and sold 60 dollars worth
of Cotton cloth,

Friday March 29th

Fair weather, Sea & land breezes
and some calm, got one bullock aboard, sold a
old whale line, The Mate and the Boatsteers
went a shore on Prophet Runaway, I say
we have the Mexicans looking for them,
the whale is forming a whale fishing here,
Aum was smuggled aboard of the ship yesterday
and all the crew was tight, 112 B. U. took
the anchor and got all sail on, went to sea,
steered off S.E. by E.

Saturday March 30th

Light wind from S.W. and
fine warm water, steering S.E. by E. Carrying
all sail, saw a steam ship steering to the S.W.
Watches employed in coiling new lines for sperm
whaling,

About 130 mile to the S.E. of the Cape
St Lucas

Off Cape Corrientes

Sunday March 31st

Light wind from S.W. and fine
warm & pleasant weather, steering S.E. Carrying
all sail & studding sails, Plenty of sheep backs
around the ship

Lat by obs 20, 41 Long by ch 107, 23

Monday March April 1st

Moderate wind from S.W. and
fine weather, steering S.E. Carrying all sail,
Watches Overhauling the fore topsail and a studding sail
saw a Humphreys. Warm weather

Lat by obs 19, 31 Long by ch 106, 15

Tuesday April 2nd

Light wind from S.W. and fine
warm weather, steering S.E. by S. Carrying all
sail, Repairing sails. Killed our last bullock,
Mr. Sylva the 2^d Officer is the officer, he
can't keep his watch a wake on deck and
he has no control over the men

Wednesday April 3rd

Light wind from S.W. and fine
weather, steering S.E. by S. Carrying all
sail, Watches repairing sails,

Lat 16, 55 by obs Long by ch ~~104~~ 104, 17

Thursday April 4th

Light airs from S.W. and fine
weather, steering S.E. Watches employed on the rig-
ging, Cooper making a new ribboom, Reppid in
the old ribboom, Plenty of boobys around the
ship

Friday April 5th

Light airs from S.W. and warm
weather, steering S.E. all sail set, Cooper making a
new ribboom, turning in the fore rigging,
