Tuesday May 7th Strong trades from S.E. and cloudy, heading S.S.W. Carrying all sail, saw nothing, watches employ'd on the rigging, I am skin shondering, I think now we have the S.E. trades fair & square Lat by obs 8, 30

Wednesday May 8th Strong wind from S.E. and cloudy weather, heading S.S.W. Carrying all sail, saw nothing. Watches employ'd on the rigging Lat by obs 10, 42

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Thursday May 9th Strong wind from S.E. and cloudy weather, heading S.S.W. Carrying all sail, watches employ'd on the rigging, At 5 P.M. raised a gain of sperm whale going to the windward fast, lowered the boats for them, but could not get on to them

Friday May 10th Strong wind from S.E. by E and fine weather, carrying all sail, heading S.W. watches employ'd on the rigging
