

Saturday (May) June 1st 1861

Light air from E and fine weather, by the wind upon opposite tacks, Broke out the main hatch and Coopers the Electraz oil, found it very slush and some of the Cash leaking.

Sunday June 2nd

Fresh breeze from E and foggy squally, Heading from ESE to SE. Carrying all sail, Saw porpoises, Caught a porpoise,

Lat by obs 53, 10 Long by obs 83, 28

Monday June 3rd

Moderate wind from ESE and E to SE and rainy, foggy weather, Working to the Eastward, Carrying all sail

Tuesday June 4th

Last night had a short wind from the W. but did not last long, Through the day calm and some foggy, A large Clipper ship 3 mile to the West of us, Steering to the Eastward, The Sun rises at 12⁰⁰ about 12 degrees high, The weather quite warm
I am making a mat

Lat about 54, 10

Wednesday June 5th

Strong gale from SE and rainy, Steering E by S. Carrying all sail, very dark nights, & Drank from 4th P.M. till 4 A.M., Run about 170 mile SE by E the last 24 hours

Off Cape Horn

Thursday June 6th

Fresh wind from NW, SE and Cloudy most the time, Steering E by S through the night & E through the day. The Sun rises in the morning about 9⁰⁰ A.M. Sets about 3 P.M., Saw a gam of Porpoises, Run SE by E 144 mile, to 4 P.M.

Friday June 7th

Strong wind from SE and Aug- ged and Rainy weather, Steering E last night, through the day, Steering ESE at 1⁰⁰ P.M. Steering SE by E, Put the log over board, At 8 P.M. the wind hauling to the Eastward on SE wind, has the appearance of a storm & the night is dark & Cloudy and cold, We have not had an observation in 5 days, I wish that we could get an observation this day,

Lat by account 58, 50 Long by Account 72, 15

Saturday June 8th

Fresh wind from SESE and thick foggy, Rainy weather, Steering SE by E. Carrying all sail, Split the fly line, Benched it, Lat about 58, 50 Long about 66, 40

Sunday June 9th

Strong wind from SESE and thick weather, Heading SE. Carrying all sail, Saw 2 Skink and a gam of Porpoises, John & Friday off duty, Sick

Lat about 58, 40 Long about 60, 26
