Wednesday June 19th

First part of the Day fresh wind from NE to E. Heading to the South, thick water. Latter part of the Day strong wind from E to SE and a thick rain storm. Came down to reef topsails, At 4 P.M. blowed a gale from SE, steering NE.

Thursday June 20th

Moderate wind from W. and fine water, steering NE. Carrying all sail, saw some whale feeds, & plenty of birds, we have had so much bad & wet water, the decks leaks all over.

Friday June 21st

Strong wind from NW and clear water, steering NE. Carrying all sail, saw nothing through the Day, repaired the gallows studing sail.

Saturday June 22nd

Light wind from SE. Steering NE, Carrying all sail, At 6 P.M. wind hauled to E. Heading NE by E. Painted fore & Mizzen royal yards, sent down the Mizzen gallard yard, painted it, John Williams & I, put the boats out, saw a Finback, saw part of a whale boat in the water.

Lat by obs 38, 20 Long by Ch 32, 46

Sunday June 23rd

Fresh wind from E. to SE. Heading from NE to NW, Carrying all sail. The Lib gun ported, tilted another, saw a Finback and some porpoises, The Montezuma leaks badly in the bow and through the Deck.

Monday June 24th

Fresh breeze from NE. Standing upon opposite tacks, saw a Finback, Carrying all sail, sent the Main royal yard down and painted it, sent the Mizzen gallard yard aloft, bent the sail making some lashings, Painted the Brotchard yard.

Tuesday June 25

Strong wind from N and rugged water, heading NE. Carrying whole top sails, Ported the Lib gun, At 6 P.M. cloudy with some rain.

Lat by obs 34, 40 Long by acct 31, 00

Wednesday June 26

Strong gale from WNW and clear water, steering NE, in the ahead beat sea, ship leaks were bad in the bow, At 5 P.M. moderate wind from S.W. and clear, set all sail, sent the main royal yard aloft.

Lat by obs 33, 40 Long by Ch 28, 45

Thursday June 27

Light wind from SE to NE. Heading from NE by N to NW. Saw a Finback, water, making some lashings, Mate sawing out the fore swifts.

Light wind from NE and some rain. Heading NW. All sail set. At 4 P.M. wind shifted to WNW, steered NE by N.
