Saturday July 20th
Fresh wind from E by S and squally
weather, At daylight this morning carried away
the fore topgalland mast in a squall. Chased a New
galland mast, At 8 this morning raised the Island
of Boranda De Rhonny found our Chronometer 4 m
minutes too slow or one degree out of the way
 Latter part of the day steered N.W. by W. An American
her majesty's ship brig past, standing by to the
S on the Starboard tack, Got up the topmast
back stays

Fresh breeze from E and fine
weather, Steering N.W. by W. Carrying all sail, Saw
a school of black fish, Sick off duty lame,

Fresh Trades from E by S
and fine weather, Steering N.W. by W. Carrying all
Saw nothing, Employed in painting the Boat
house, and pulling down the fore & main
rigging, Sent the Mizen galland Mast aloft,

Sat by obs 38 miles North

Tuesday July 23rd
Fresh S.E. Trades and fine weather
Steering N.W. by W. Carrying all sail, Cooper a painting
Employed in pulling down the lee side of the
Rigging, Sent aloft the Mizen galland & Mizen
and Sat the sails, Strong current in the water

Sat by obs 3, 29 North

Wednesday July 24th
Moderate wind from S.E. and
fine warm weather, Steering N.W. by W. All sail set
Watchers employed in pulling down the Starboard
side of the main & Mizen rigging, and the fore topmast
rigging, St. C. Anna seen

Sat by obs 5.28 Long by ch 38, 40

Thursday July 25th
First part of this day light wind
from S.E. and fine weather, Latter part of the day
light airs from S.E. and calm, An old
sloop coming from N.W. and the clouds
cleared up from that quarter, Saw lightning
in the N.E. last night, Watchers employed
on the rigging & pulling down
