

June 8th

All the 24 hours strong gales and squally at 1 P.M. saw the
Honest and Brighton chasing whales at 4 the Horses took 1
to the ship saw the Whales going quick to windward but did
not lose. Latter part saw one seal Lat 23-56

June 9th

Begins light wind and squally saw plenty of Fin Backs
Mid and Latter part fine weather 2 seal in sight Lat 23-51

June 9th

All this day light air and clear at noon saw a ship to the
Leward take a Whale so end Lat 24-00

June 10th

Begins with a strong breeze at 2 P.M. saw a ship
Whale Lined and struck the Iron Drunken at sundown 6 seal
in sight spoke the Brunswick Branchester of Providence 1000
200 spm Latter part saw nothing but ships Lat 24-50 South

June 11th

All this day fine weather saw a number of Fin Backs
and 4 ships one cutting so end Lat 24-14 S

June 12th

All the 24 hours light air and clear at 6 spoke the
ships Lucy Ann Cox of Wilmington 1000 spm North Star
Masher of Wren 300 spm 150 to the Brunswick 500 to
300 spm the Leonides of Fair Haven 170 spm ends with
fine weather 6 seal in sight

June 13th

Lat 24-02

Fine and Mid part light air latter part strong breeze from East
standing to the S.W. 6 ships in sight

Lat 23-58 South

June 14th

All this day strong gales from SE at 6 P.M. spoke the ship
Discovery of London 700 spm ends 2 seal in sight

June 15th

Lat 23-56

All the 24 hours light air and pleasant at 4 P.M. spoke
the Friendship Taker of Fairhaven 1500-400 spm

Lat 23-45

June 16th

All the 24 hours light air and clear tacked and detached
saw nothing but ships so end 8 seal in sight

June 17th

Lat 24-14 South

First and Middle part light air and clear
Latter part strong gales at 11 A.M. lowered for a Stump
Back but did not strike so ends one seal in sight

Lat 23-52 S Ly 110-002

June 18th

All this day strong gales and cloudy at 6 P.M. spoke
the Portland of Sag Harbor 1600 lbs 80 spm at 10 A.M.
spoke the Huntspe of N.B. 1350 lbs 50 spm so ends

Lat 24-27

June 19th

All this day strong gales and cloudy at 6 P.M. spoke the
ships Hogue West 2200 lbs 200 spm the Mercia Masher
900 lbs 300 spm ends strong gales in evening with
the Huntspe saw 4pm Whales lined and got one the
Huntspe the same so ends this day took the Whale
to the ship and got ready for cutting
