

Ship Montpelier From Coas Islands Bound South
Friday Aug 15th

Commences with a gale from E with plenty of rain
headed E by E under close reefed Top Sails and fore
sail. Middle part the same latter part more moderate
Set the E Sails. Bent a New Gill and Set it
Ends the day saw nothing No Tell

Saturday Aug 15th

Reigns strong gale from E. E. headed S E at 10 PM
hoisted the Gill and main sail at 2 set the other
sail at 2 recubent the M. Top sail and bent
a new one Middle part moderate Set the up and
the Tails Ends fine weather all sail Set Lat 23 46 = 91 27

Sunday Aug 16th

Commences light air and pleasant headed S E
employed in mending the Fore sail at sunset
bent it a Middle and latter part much
the same as the first Employed in pointing
the Mainmast. Bent also Ends the day Lat 23 37 = 92 11

Monday Aug 17th

Reigns light air and calm headed S E
Middle part a Puddles Hurricane latter a
fine breeze from S backed ship to the E
Thus Ends the day and saw nothing
Employed in mending the Gill Lat 24 30

Tuesday Aug 18th

Commences with light air from S E
at 4 PM backed ship to the S E W Middle
and latter part much the same as the
first Employed in mending the Gill so
Ends another day saw nothing Lat 25 26

Wednesday Aug 19th

Commences with a fine breeze and pleasant
weather headed S Middle and latter part
light air and calm on thick overcast weather
Employed in Repairing the Gill so
Ends the day saw nothing No Tell

Thursday Aug 20th

First and middle parts a dead Calm and cloudy
employed in mending the Gill latter part
light air from E W steered S E by E Thus
Ends the day Employed in mending the Gill Lat 26 01

Friday Aug 21st

Reigns light air from S W steering S E by E
at 4 PM bent down the T Top sail and bent
the old M. Top sail in its place latter part a
fine breeze at 6 PM Lat 26 19 = 94 23

Saturday Aug 22nd

All three 24 hours a fine breeze from the Southern
headed E by E all sail set latter part unbent the
M. sail so Ends the day Employed in mending
the Main sail saw nothing Lat 26 10 = 96 01

Sunday Aug 23rd

All three 24 hours light winds from S E
steering S E with the Main sail on deck mending
it at 4 PM got it done and bent it Ends cloudy
weather nothing in sight Lat 26 30 = 97 05

Monday Aug 24th

Reigns with strong gale from the Southern
standing to the E E Middle part light
air latter a fine breeze from S E W
steering S E so Ends saw Finbacks Lat 26 43 = 99 22

Tuesday Aug 25th

Reigns with a fine breeze from S standing to
the Eastward saw plenty of Finbacks middle part
the same at 5 AM backed to the S E W
and the same saw Finbacks Lat 26 45

Wednesday Aug 26th

Reigns fine weather standing to the S E W
employed in mending Fore T sail Middle part the
same latter part light air and calm so Ends
the day saw plenty of Finbacks Lat 27 35
