

Monday Oct. 14th

Begins fine weather at 1 took the school to the ship got dinner and commenced cutting at 8 finished cutting and took in sail two ships in sight a bathing at 8 began to boil at 11 close reef the chain top sail at 2 A.M. it blowed a Heavy Gale from N.W. took in the Tails and locked down set post stunsail up B and W. Boat so Ends Nothing in sight

Tuesday Oct. 15th

Begins a Heavy Gale from N.W. trying to the Southward under Close reef M. P. sail and post the same Concludes much the same with Heavy squalls and rain Nothing in sight Lat 36.06

Wednesday Oct. 16th

Begins a Gale N.W. trying to the S.W. at 1 more ships to the S and turned down the Boats at 3 a Little more storm moderate set the F sail Middle part the same at daylight hauled all Hanks and went to Boiling Ends the same storm wind from S.W. standing to the W under double reef F and Main Top sails and F sail & sail in sight and plenty of Fishes Lat 38.05 Long 114.23

Thursday Oct. 17th

Begins strong wind from S and squally standing W. under Double reef F and M Top sails employed in Boiling one sail in sight at 8 took in F Top sail & Middle part the same at 8 finished Boiling Concludes fine weather & sail in sight

Friday Oct. 18th

All these 24 hours fine weather and Light airs from S. at 5 P.M. spoke the Jefferson and Boston 900

Saturday Oct. 19th

Begins fine weather and Light airs from S standing to the S.W. in Company with the Jefferson and Boston Middle and Latter part calm so ends the day Lat 34.32 Long 112.49

Sunday Oct. 20th

Begins light airs and calm standing to the S and at 1 saw the other ships Boats Chasing sperm Whales Landed our Boats Boat could not strike The Boston got a Large Whale at sundown took in sail and lay to this I at daylight saw a School of Large sperm whales Landed but could not strike Ends fine weather the Jefferson in sight Lat 34.54

Monday Oct. 21st

Begins light airs from S.W. standing to the S.E. at sundown Middle part the same at daylight Made all sail at 8 A.M. picked up a large sperm Whale Flew out at 11 and began to Boil to ends the day the Jefferson in sight Lat 35.42 Long 113.05

Tuesday Oct. 22nd

Begins pleasant weather and a fine breeze from W employed in Boiling at Dark saw the Jefferson take a Whale along side took in sail and lay to the S.W. at 1 finished Boiling Landed post a strong breeze from S and thick overcast weather with some rain so ends the day the Jefferson in sight No Obs

Wednesday Oct. 23rd

Begins with strong breeze from S and thick overcast weather Middle part the same Latter part fine weather stood E.S.E. saw nothing but porpoises so ends the day Lat 35.50 Long 113.18
