

Thursday Oct 22nd

Begins with a fine breeze from E and
 Chop steering E employed in Mending I
 I sail at sundown took in sail and stored
 the same a number of Line Boats in sight
 Latter part fine weather Stead E with
 all sail set so Ends saw 2 Boats Lat 36.04, Long 114.22

Friday Oct 23rd



Begins with a strong breeze from S.W.
 Steering E at 8 struck and saved a Porpoise
 at 8 saw a Carcass to the Sea and run off for
 it on raise 2 Whight Whales near it lowered
 the Boats and threw 2 iron into one and
 they both broke went on board and took in
 sail and store to the S at daylight Made
 sail at 9 A.M. more ship to the S at the
 same time saw Whight Whales lowered
 the Boats and struck two at 12 took them
 to the ship so Ends the day plenty of
 Whales and two sails in sight Lat 36.12

Saturday Oct 24th

Begins fine weather at half past 12
 Begon to cut at 6 finished cutting
 took in sail and Begon to boil
 two ships cutting to the Windward
 Latter part fine weather saw one Whale
 lowered and got him so Ends Lat 35.56

Sunday Oct 25th

Begins fine weather at 1/2 past 2 took the
 whale to the ship got him on and began to
 cut at half past 5 finished cutting took
 in sail and store to the S Latter part
 a strong breeze did not make any sail
 all hands employed in stowing down
 oil so Ends the day 1 sail in sight
 and 1 Whale

Ship Montpelier on Weight Whales Given
 Monday Oct 26th

Begins with a strong breeze and a heavy swell
 from the W standing southerly under double reef
 M.T. sail and F. sail all hands employed in Boiling
 and stowing down at 5 saw a number of Whales
 lowered 2 Boats and started 3 times but did not get
 fast Latter a dead Calm saw nothing but one sail
 so Ends Employed in boiling Lat 36.54 Long 115.09.30

Tuesday Oct 27th

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Begins Light air and Calm employed in boiling
 at 6 A.M. finished boiling Made sail and went
 to stowing down at 9 saw a Whale lowered and
 started without success at 11 went off struck got
 the Bow Boat down 2 Boats fast to the Whale
 and both endeavored so Ends the day Lat 37.11

Wednesday Oct 28th

Begins Light air from W at 3 saw a ship
 take a Whale along side at 6 saw a Large Spine
 Whale ^{going to the S} lowered two Boats at sunset gave up
 the Chaser went on Boats shortened sail and
 stood to the S.W. after the Whale at 4
 A.M. tacked to the N at daylight Made
 all sail saw plenty of fine Boats at 1/2 past
 11 saw plenty of Whales lowered 3 Boats and
 struck 1 Whale so Ends the day one sail
 in sight Lat 36.50

Thursday Oct 29th

Begins a strong Breeze from S.W. at 3
 M. took the Whale to the ship and
 began to cut at 12 past 5 finished
 cutting then ship to the S.W. at sunset
 double reefed the F. sails plenty of Whales
 in sight at daylight Begon to Boil
 Ends the same Blowing a gale from
 S.W. standing to the S on sails in
 sight Lat 36.40 Long 114.39
